

BRAC symposium from tomorrow

BRAC University will organise a three-day long international symposium on 'Regulatory and Safety Issues in the Commercialisation of Biotechnology Research in the Developing Countries' in the city from December 2.

The symposium is designed to provide information to relevant stakeholders and to educate practicing biotechnologists and other professionals on intellectual Property Rights (IPR), patents, bio-safety, bioethics, regulatory affairs, and other regulatory issues involved in field and clinical trials, and in the commercialisation of biotech research products.

A large number of participants from home and abroad are expected to participate in the symposium to be organised in collaboration with ICGEB, Italy and exchange views on relevant issues.

Eminent experts on bio-safety, bio-ethics, IPR and regulatory issues from different countries and scientists working in different universities and organisations within the country will take part.
