## Brac University ranks top 50 globally for SDG 1

Brac University has ranked global top 50 for "Sustainable development goals (SDGs) 1: no poverty'" in Times Higher Education (THE) impact rankings 2020.

The impact rankings 2020 announcement was released in London on April 22. The standings of the university are 201-300 (SDG 3), 201-300 (SDG 16) and 301-400 (SDG 17) globally in their rankings. Brac University got the 1st position in Bangladesh and 301-400th globally, says a Brac University press release.
