Inter-varsity Mathematics Olympiad held:

DHAKA, DEC 11: The Department of Mathematics and Natural Sciences (MNS) of BRAC University (BRACU) organised 'Inter-university Mathematics Olympiad-2011' on Friday in collaboration with Bangladesh Mathematical Society (BMS), says a press release. The aim of this Mathematical Olympiad was to create the opportunity for the young talented undergraduate students in the country to stand out and illustrate their mathematical and analytical skills. In addition, endeavour was to create a national awareness for the development of mathematics education at the tertiary level and skills in Bangladesh.
