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

11. Giving physical support to the client if necessary.

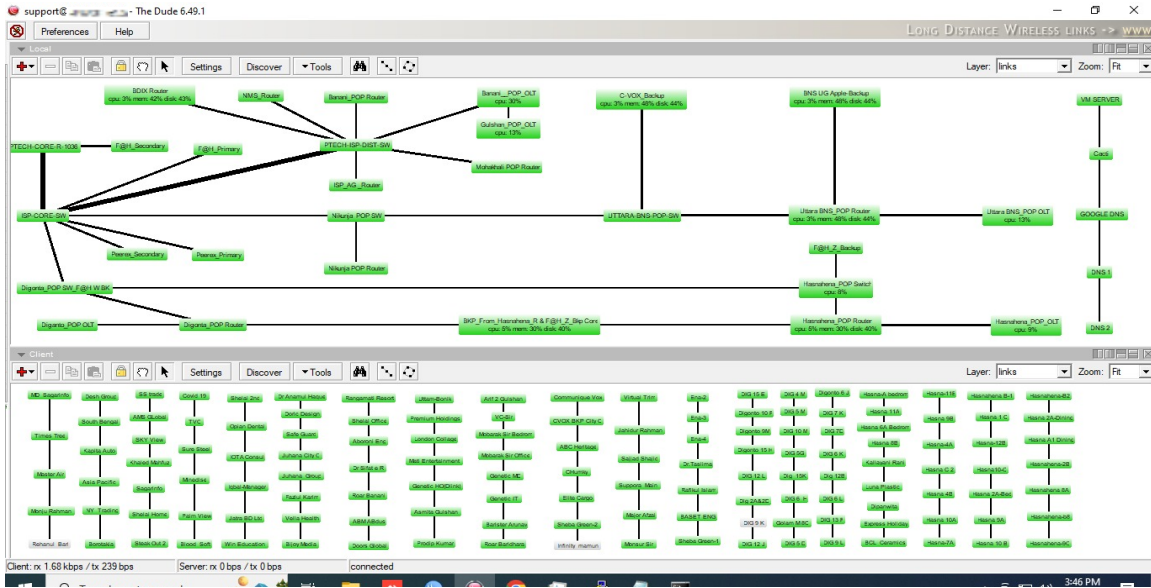


Figure 2.1: The Dude App for network interface & client status monitoring.

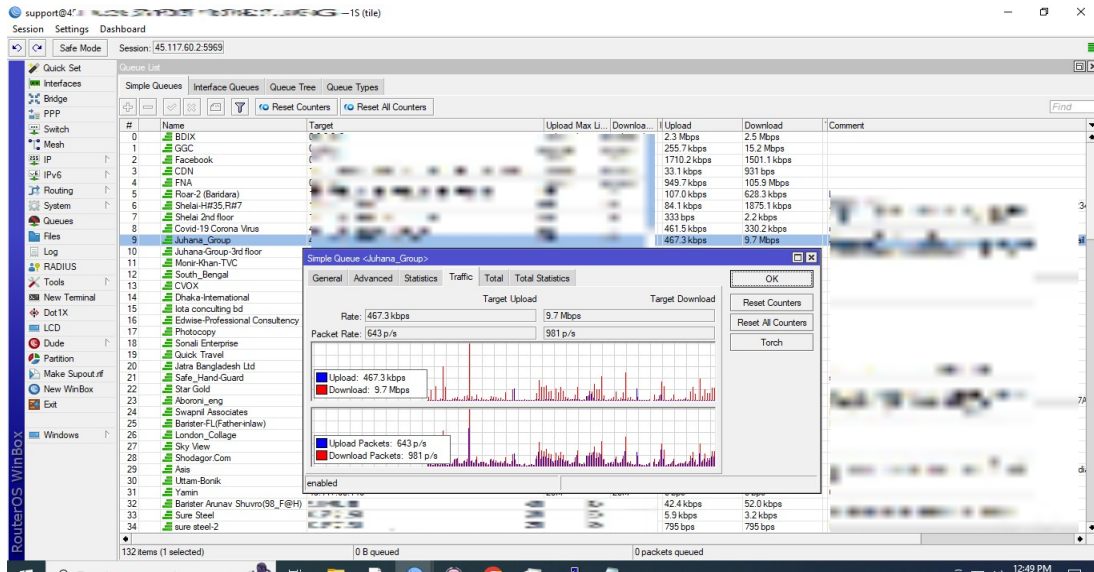


Figure 2.5: Client's bandwidth traffic monitoring from Mikrotik WinBox.

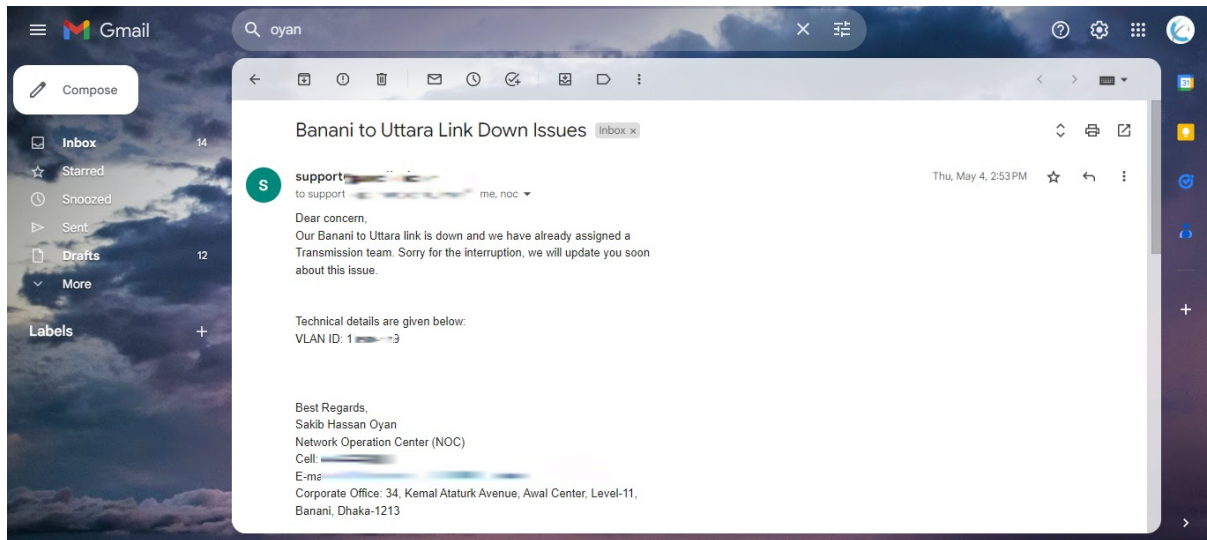


Figure 2.9: Sending email to the client in case of emergency situations.

Chapter 3

CONSTRAINTS/CHALLENGES

3.1 Identified/Observed in the Organization:

At Paradise Technologies Limited, the work environment was not always one that encouraged productivity. Sometimes the workplace was too packed, which made it hard for me to concentrate and work well. This sometimes prevented me from properly contacting the clients. Additionally, there were not enough other tools to practice with. In the absence of these abilities, it needs to be focused on improving analytical and critical thinking abilities. Working with other team members is certainly required to achieve common goals. Everyone, therefore, needs to be able to work together in an effective collaborative environment. If these abilities are lacking, it is necessary to concentrate on developing relationships with colleagues and improving one's communication and interpersonal abilities.
