

Mock interview session held at BRACU

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The Career Services Office at BRAC University organises mock interview session every semester as a “modular component” of its Professional Skills Development Program (PSDP). The aim is to provide prospective graduates an insight into the challenges of real-life interviews.

On 29 December, 2012, the mock interview session for the Fall 2012 students took place at the university’s Mohakhali campus.

Twenty business houses and NGOs participated in the session.
