

Memorial program in honour of Professor Piash Karim at BRACU



BRAC University organised a memorial program in honour of Professor Piash Karim on October 16. The program was held at the university auditorium with over 200 students and faculty members. The day was spent the way Dr. Karim loved -- with poetry, music, laughter and passionate, informal conversation -- and ended with prayers. Dr. Piash Karim published in a number of journals and left an impression in the literary scene. Some of his publications include "U.S. Media and the Cambodian Crisis" (1998), "Fragmented Encounters: Serajul Islam Chowdhury" (2002), "Language, Nation and Multiplicity: A Bakhtinian Analysis" (2006). He held the position of Assistant Professor at the Department of Sociology in University of Nebraska from 1989-1990 and became an Associate Professor at the Department of Sociology in Culver-Stockton College in 1995. In 2007 he joined BRAC University as Associate Professor and was promoted to a Professor in 2011.
