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## **INTRODUCTION**

To mobilize partnership for Non-formal primary Education for the eradication of illiteracy from Bangladesh, BRAC undertook the Education Support Program (ESP) in September 1991. Till 31 December 1994, ESP had extended its support to 185 non-government organizations (NGOs) for 3567 NFPE schools. BRAC's ESP has been providing technical support to all these organizations and technical as well as financial support to 138 NGOs, 26 from November 1991, 20 from November 1992, one from January 1993, 40 from June 1994 and 51 from October 1994, for 1475 schools. Among these 1475 schools, 129 schools had completed the 3-year course in December 1994. Two hundred thirty four (234) schools are now running class-II and will start third year courses from February/March 1995. One thousand twelve (1012) schools are now running class-1. For the rest 100 schools, organizing activities are going on. These schools are expected to open in February 1995. For the implementation and management of the Non-formal Primary Education Program (NFPE), each of these organizations has appointed one Program Organizer (PO). ESP comprises of one Manager and sixteen Program Organizers having two to six years of working experience in NFPE and/or ESP. These 1475 schools are being funded mostly from BRAC's own sources. OXFAM-UK has been providing funds for 100 schools.

## **RATIONALE FOR UNDERTAKING ESP**

BRAC's Non-formal Primary Education (NFPE) went into operation in 1985 with 22 schools and 667 students. Soon it was proved that NFPE was cost effective, relevant for social change with regard to the position of girls, and could provide the basis for solution to the problems of primary education in rural area. As a World Bank sponsored evaluation study suggests "to cover children

of the disadvantaged communities under this non-formal education program. BRAC's ideas, policies, and strategies may appropriately be utilized" (Begum, K. and others, 1988, p. 124).

Before September 1991, attempts had been made by some NGOs to replicate NFPE model. Although no indepth study was made to measure the degree of success of these efforts, off hand observations showed that none of the NGOs involved could run schools over a full course period successfully as per NFPE standard operational procedures. This not only involved a waste of funds for the organizations concerned but meant a waste of time for BRAC who had invested much training and professional time into these ventures. Recognizing this and to help eradicate illiteracy from Bangladesh, BRAC undertook the Education Support Program (ESP) in September 1991. Through ESP BRAC hopes to share its expertise in (a) school organization, (b) teacher training, (c) staff training, (d) classroom management and instruction, (e) making the community participate in the program, (f) school supervision, (g) progress monitoring, and (h) development of curriculum and materials with other organizations.

### **GOAL OF ESP**

The goal of ESP is "to form partnership for non-formal primary education with organizations working in Bangladesh and to develop their technical, conceptual, and human skills to replicate BRAC's NFPE model successfully."

### **OBJECTIVES OF ESP**

The main objectives of ESP are to:

- form partnership for non-formal primary education.
- develop partner organizations' skills to replicate BRAC's NFPE model.



- ensure women's participation in the implementation and management of primary education program.
- minimize wastage of time, money, and human lives in primary educational enterprises in Bangladesh.
- promote girls education, and
- to support national efforts towards basic education for all.

## **THE ESP PARTNERS**

By 31 December 1994, ESP had formed its partnership for non-formal primary education with 185 NGOs. ESP has been providing technical support to all these 185 organizations. One hundred thirty eight (138) NGOs had received technical as well as financial support from BRAC. Among these 138 NGOs, 26 NGOs received 58 percent of the total cost of the program for three years from November 1991 for 129 NFPE schools. These schools were opened in march, 1992. Performance of these schools were far above the expectation of the partners. The success of these schools motivated the partners to open more schools. In January 1993, ESP extended its financial support to a additional 125 NFPE schools belonging to 25 organizations of the 26 organizations mentioned above. For these 125 schools, ESP bears the full cost. From November 1992, ESP has been providing full financial support to 20 NGOs for 100 NFPE schools (five schools for each). In January 1993, ESP further extended its financial support to one more NGO for 20 NFPE schools. In year 1994, ESP extended its financial support covering full cost to 37 existing partner NGOs and 91 new partner NGOs respectively for 205 and 902 NFPE schools. From January 1995, ESP stopped providing its financial support to one NGO which received financial support for five (5) NFPE schools from November 1991 for a full three-year NFPE cycle. Now 137 NGOs are receiving full financial

support from ESP for 1346 schools. In addition, ESP has been bearing the material cost of one NGO for 32 schools and training cost of another NGO for 4 schools. Forty five partner NGOs provide the funding for their NFPE programs from their own sources.

### **Partners receiving financial support from BRAC's ESP**

It is already mentioned that now ESP has been providing full financial support for 1346 NFPE schools to 137 partner NGOs. A few of these NGOs are based in Dhaka. On the average, the yearly budget of these organizations is Taka 1500000 and the number of permanent staffs is 16. Names of these NGOs, their NFPE locations, and the number of schools are shown in table 1.

### **THE ESP FINANCED SCHOOLS (ESP NFPE SCHOOLS)**

Till December 1994, total number of schools financed by ESP (ESP NFPE schools) was 1475. Among these 1475 schools, 129 schools had completed the three year course in December 1994. Now BRAC's Education Support Program (ESP) is providing funding for 1346 NFPE schools administered by 137 partner NGOs. Among these 1346 schools, 234 schools are now in the second year or class-II and will begin third year courses from February/March 1995. One thousand twelve (1012) schools are in the first year or class-I. For the rest 100 schools, organizing works are going on and are

expected to open in February 1994. Now the total number of on-going ESP NFPE schools is 1246. Total enrolment in these 1246 schools is 37380 with an average enrolment of 30. More than 74 per cent of students are girls. Children aged 8-10 years are selected to be enrolled in ESP NFPE schools.

### **The on-going ESP NFPE schools**

It is already mentioned that the total number of on-going ESP NFPE schools is now 1246 with a total enrolment of 37360. Among these 1246 schools, 234 schools are in the second year or class-II and will begin third year courses in February/March 1995. Total enrolment in these 234 schools is 7020 with an average enrolment of 30. Five thousand two hundred and thirty nine (5239) or 75 per cent students of the total enrolment are girls and the rest 1781 or 25 per cent students are boys. A list of class-II schools (by organization); number of students, and the percentages of boys and girls are shown in appendix A. One thousand twelve (1012) schools are now in the first year or class-I. Total enrolment in these 1012 ESP NFPE schools is 30,360 with an average enrolment of 30. About 72 per cent of the total students of the first year schools are girls. A list of class-I schools (organization wise); number of students, and the percentages of boys and girls are shown in appendix B. Average attendance in ESP NFPE schools is 94.20 per cent. In the class-II schools average student attendance is 91.16 per cent and in the class-I schools average student attendance is 97.23 per cent. Measures have been taken to increase student attendance in class-II schools and, it is expected, the average student attendance in class-II schools will increase to about 94 per cent by June 1995. Student attendance in class-I and class-II schools are show in appendix C and D respectively. Students performance is satisfactory. Strategies that can likely ensure the learning for each and every child are carefully followed in ESP



NFPE schools. The children learn what they are expected to learn. Along with the curricular activities the co-curricular activities in the ESP NFPE schools are so designed and performed that these help develop students' competencies in different modes of communication and thereby make them cultured human beings. Till December 31 1993, it is reported, total number of dropout children in the class-II schools is seven (7). Among these seven children four are dead. So, dropouts in the sense of failure to continue study (as UNICEF defines) are three or 0.04 percent in the class-II schools. In the class-I schools there is no dropout.

There is one teacher for each of the on-going 1246 schools. One thousand two hundred and twenty five (1225) or 98 percent of teachers are female and 824 or 66 percent of total number of teachers have passed Secondary School Certificate examination. Appendix E gives information about teaching staff; their sex, academic qualification, and marital status.

The ESP NFPE school houses look like NFPE school houses. For a ESP NFPE school house, a monthly rent of Tk.100-150 is paid to the house owner per month. Community participation is much valued in ESP NFPE. The ESP's partners realize that no program can be successful without the active participation of its beneficiaries. To administer the NFPE program, each of the 137 partners has appointed its own Program Organizer(s). Most of the Program organizers are graduates or hold a masters degree. They perform all field activities including the organization and facilitation of teacher refresher courses.

### **The schools completed the three year course**

In December 1994, 129 ESP NFPE schools attuned by 26 partner NGOs completed the three year course. Total enrolment in these 129 schools was 3870. One thousand forty eight (1048) students or 27 per cent of total enrolment were boys and 2822 or 73 per cent of total enrolment were girls. Three



thousand eight hundred and eight (3808) students or 98.39 per cent of total students completed the three year course. Total dropouts were 62 or 1.61 per cent. Three thousand six hundred and sixty two (3662) students or 96 per cent of the students who completed the course were admitted into primary or secondary schools; 2625 in class four, 925 in class five, and 112 in class six. Number of schools that completed the three year course, enrolment in the schools, number of students who completed the three year course, and number of students admitted into primary or secondary schools are shown (organization wise) in appendix F.

## **IMPLEMENTATION AND MANAGEMENT OF ESP PROJECTS**

The most important feature of ESP management is that ESP gets the work done through others. ESP implements its projects through partner NGOs. The Manager of ESP is entrusted with the responsibilities of the projects within the present administrative structure of BRAC. Sixteen experienced Program Organizers (POs)/Area Managers (AMs) have been deployed to assist the Manager. The organogram of ESP is given in appendix G.

To implement ESP projects, the following strategies are followed.

Before starting operations at the field level, a 2-day orientation program on NFPE and ESP is organized by ESP for the partner NGO heads. ESP firmly believes that for the successful replication of NFPE the heads of the partner NGOs must appreciate the program design and should have positive attitude toward NFPE and ESP.

For the implementation and management of the NFPE program, each of partner organizations has its own Program organizer (s). Most of the Program

Organizers are Graduates or hold a masters degree

Program Organizers of partner NGOs are responsible for all field level activities. Before starting operational activities, the POs of partner organizations are also provided a 4-day training on school organization.

Selection of NFPE village, children selection, teacher selection, arrangement of school accommodation, organization of parents, organization and facilitation of teacher refresher courses, school supervision, and other activities are performed by POs of partner NGOs. They do these in consultation with the POs/AMs of ESP and their respective supervisors in their own organizations and on the basis of guidelines provided by them.

POs of partner NGOs are accountable to the respective supervisors of their own organizations. But they submit weekly and monthly reports on the progress of project activities to ESP POs/AMs and/or to the Manager of ESP.

ESP provides training to the teachers and staffs of partner NGOs. Before receiving 12-day teacher training no NGO is provided with NFPE materials (printed).

The POs of partner NGOs usually visit each school twice a week. During the visit they carefully observe the progress of school activities and provide suggestions to the teachers to develop instructional strategies and classroom management.

The POs of partner NGOs submit weekly and monthly school visit reports and the reports on monthly parents meeting to ESP POs/AMs and/or to the Manager of ESP. They also submit these reports to their respective supervisors. ESP provides feedback on these reports.

ESP POs/AMs visit the partner NGOs and their schools once in a month. They check the validity of the reports and provide feedback on the progress of the project activities to POs of partner NGOs and NGO heads and suggest

measures to improve the quality of the program. During their visit, they carefully observe various aspects of man, material, and money management, school activities, student achievement, and others and collect information needed to prepare a report in the format titled "MONITORING OF NFPE UNDERTAKEN BY PARTNER ORGANIZATION" (Appendix H) and developed by ESP. The form contains 34 items to be ranked on a five-point rating scale. ESP POs/AMs are equipped with the necessary knowledge, skills, and attitude to rank the items objectively.

One hundred thirty seven NGOs are now receiving supervision and monitoring services from ESP. Considering the NFPE locations of the partner NGOs ESP has divided them into sixteen areas. Sixteen ESP POs/AMs are working as In-charges of these sixteen areas. Most of them are based at BRAC's field offices. The ESP areas, NGOs within each area, and the respective In-charges are shown in appendix I.

ESP POs/AMs submit monthly monitoring reports on NFPE attuned by the partner NGOs to the Manager of ESP. The Manager of ESP also visits the partner NGOs and their schools time to time. He provides feedback to Pos of partner NGOs, heads of the partner NGOs, and to ESP POs/AMs. He also suggests or takes measures to maintain or to improve the quality of the project.

ESP provides financial supports to the partner NGOs in goods, services, and money. Goods are provided in three instalments. Each instalment covers the requirements of one year. Money is provided in six instalments. This has been proved to be an effective strategies to minimize BRAC's cost and to check wastage and misappropriation.

### **COST OF ESP NFPE**

ESP is now providing full financial support to 137 NGOs for 1346 NFPE



schools. Estimated total cost of these 1346 schools for three years is Taka 82783038 which includes Taka12417455 for ESP's consultancy, monitoring, and supervision services. Depending on contextual situation, cost per school differs from project to project. On the average, estimated cost for three years is Taka 61503 a school and cost per child per year is Taka 683 or US 17.08 dollars.

## **CONCLUDING REMARKS**

ESP has been working for the last four years. Now it is proved that partnership for non-formal primary education among non-government organizations (NGOs) in Bangladesh can work effectively and efficiently. ESP has been providing financial as well as technical support to 138 NGOs for 1475 schools. Among these 1475 schools, 129 schools have completed the three year course, 234 schools are in the second year or class-II, 1012 schools are in the first year or class-I, and initial organizing activities are going on for rest 100 schools. Average attendance of students in the ESP NFPE schools is 94.20 per cent. In the class-1 schools average attendance is 97.23 per cent and in the class-2 schools the average attendance is 91.16 per cent. Students achievement is satisfactory. In the ESP NFPE schools, the teachers follow instructional strategies that likely ensure the learning for each and every child. ESP always tries to design the classroom instruction by simultaneously considering alternative inputs and processes or the means by which educational inputs are transformed into educational outputs (cognitive achievement, skill development, attitudinal changes, and behavioral changes). Perhaps, a good interaction of inputs and process contributes significantly to the economy of teaching in the ESP NFPE schools. Cost per child per year in a ESP NFPE school is Taka 683 or US 17.08 dollars. Hence ESP NFPE is

effective and efficient both technologically and economically. Actual cost could be reduced remarkably if ESP could open more schools through the existing partners because no more ESP staff will be required to provide the monitoring, consultancy, and supervision services for these schools. Considering the above realities ESP desires to extend its financial as well as technical support to the existing and new partner NGOs for opening 2000 NFPE schools by 31 December 1995. Efforts of the partners, not receiving financial support from BRAC, toward the eradication of illiteracy from Bangladesh is also praiseworthy. ESP is keen to provide them with every kind of technical support possible.

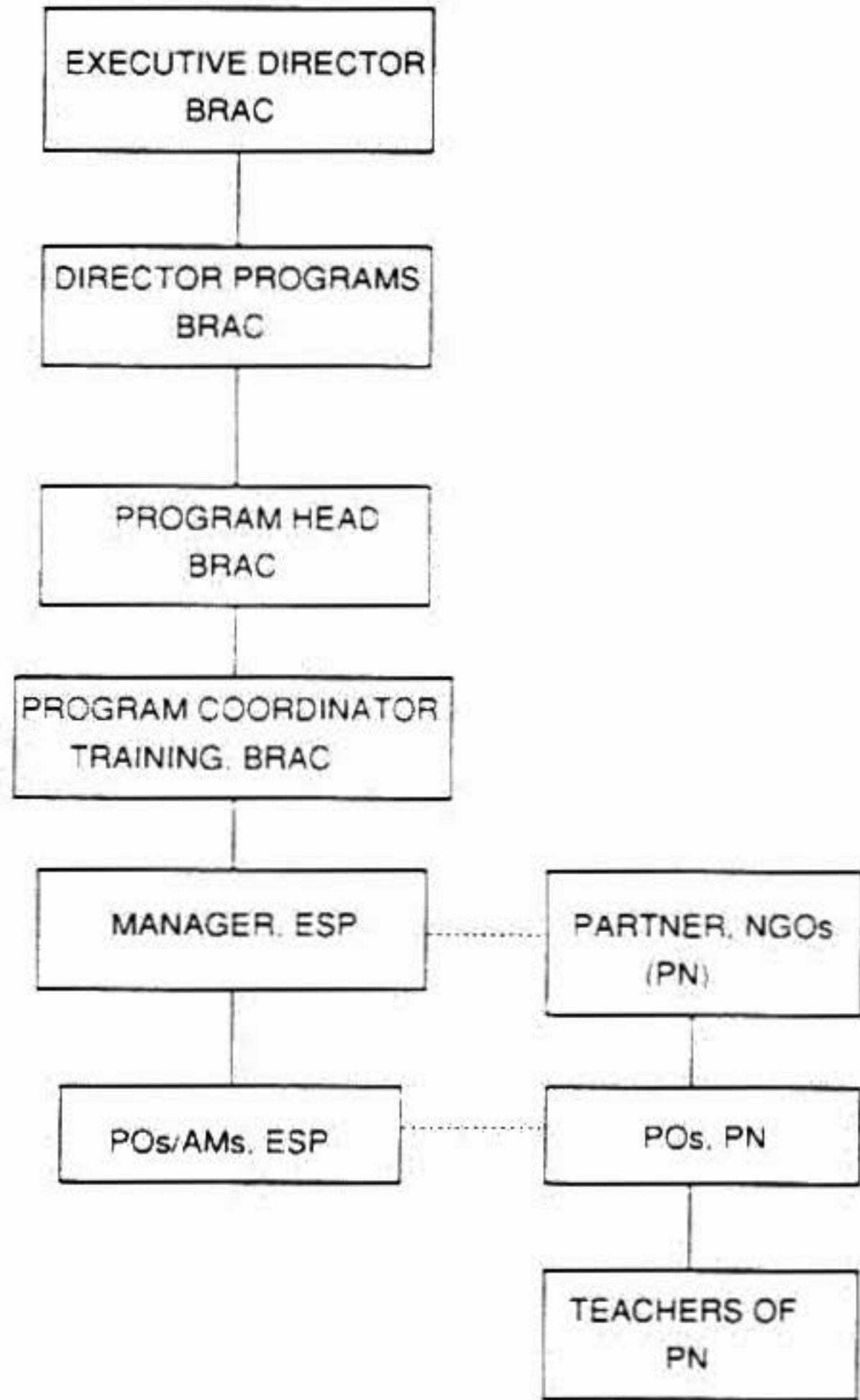
