INTRODUCTION

Mobilizing partnership for Non-formal Primary Education and augmenting efforts towards the eradication of illiteracy from Bangladesh, BRAC undertook the Education Support Program (ESP) in September 1991. Till 30 April 1999, ESP had extended its support to 381 non-government organizations (NGOs) for 8113 NFPE schools. BRAC's ESP has provided technical support to all these organizations and technical as well as financial support to 325 NGOs for 4860 schools. Among these 4860 schools, 2315 had completed the three year course. Nine hundred forty (940) schools are now running class-I, 1010 schools are now running class-II, and 595 schools are now running class-III. Forty one (41) among the 325 NGOs which received financial support were dropped by ESP after the completion of the 3-year course due to their inefficiency and management problem. Now 284 NGOs are receiving technical as well as financial support from BRAC's ESP for 2545 schools. For the implementation and management of the Non-formal Primary Education Program (NFPE), each of these organizations has appointed one Program Organizer (PO). ESP comprises of one Program Manager and 29 Program Organizer-Technical Support Specialists (PO-TSSs) having five (5) to eight (9) years of working experience in NFPE and/or ESP.

RATIONALE FOR UNDERTAKING ESP

BRAC's Non-formal Primary Education (NFPE) went into operation in 1985 with 22 schools and 667 students. Soon it was proved that NFPE was cost effective, relevant for social change with regard to the position of girls, and could provide the basis for solution to the problems of primary education in rural area. As a World Bank sponsored evaluation study suggests "to cover children of the disadvantaged communities under this non-formal education program, BRAC's ideas, policies, and strategies may appropriately be utilized" (Begum, K. and others, 1988, p. 124).

Before September 1991, attempts had been made by some NGOs to replicate NFPE

model. Although no indepth study was made to measure the degree of success of these efforts, off hand observations showed that none of the NGOs involved could run schools over a full course period successfully as per NFPE standard operational procedures. This not only involved a waste of funds for the organizations concerned but meant a waste of time for BRAC who had invested much training and professional time into these ventures. Recognizing this and to help eradicate illiteracy from Bangladesh, BRAC undertook the Education Support Program (ESP) in September 1991. Through ESP BRAC hopes to share its expertise in (a) school organization, (b) teacher training, (c) staff training, (d) classroom management and instruction, (e) making the community participate in the program, (f) school supervision, (g) progress monitoring, and (h) development of curriculum and materials with other organizations.

GOAL OF ESP

The goal of ESP is "to form partnership for non-formal primary education with organizations working in Bangladesh and to develop their technical, conceptual, and human skills to replicate BRAC's NFPE model successfully."

OBJECTIVES OF ESP

The main objectives of ESP are to:

- form partnership for non-formal primary education,
- develop partner organizations' skills to replicate BRAC's NFPE model,
- ensure women's participation in the implementation and management of primary education program,
- minimize wastage of time, money, and human lives in primary educational enterprises in Bangladesh,
- promote girls education, and
- to support national efforts towards basic education for all.

THE ESP PARTNERS

By 30 April 1999, ESP had formed its partnership for non-formal primary education with 381 NGOs. ESP has provided technical support to all these 381 organizations. Three hundred twenty five (325) NGOs had received technical as well as financial support from BRAC. Among these 325 NGOs, 26 NGOs received 58 percent of the total cost of the program for three years from November 1991 for 129 NFPE schools. These schools were opened in march, 1992. Performance of these schools were far above the expectation of the partners. The success of these schools motivated the partners to open more schools. In January 1993, ESP extended its financial support to a additional 125 NFPE schools belonging to 25 organizations of the 26 organizations mentioned above. For these 125 schools, ESP bore the full cost. In November 1992, ESP began providing full financial support to 20 NGOs for 99 NFPE schools for the whole 3-year NFPE cycle. In January 1993, ESP further extended its financial support to one more NGO for 20 NFPE schools. In year 1994, ESP extended its financial support covering full cost to 37 existing partner NGOs and 91 new partner NGOs respectively for 200 and 897 NFPE schools. Again in June 1995, ESP extended its financial support to 140 NGOs covering full cost for 700 schools. In 1996, ESP provided support for 230 schools to 39 existing partner NGOs who successfully completed the full 3-year course of the same number of NFPE schools. In 1997 and 1998, ESP extended its support for opening 1520 and 15 schools respectively. In January 1999, ESP extended its support for opening 925 NFPE schools through 177 partner NGOs. By January 1999, ESP had stopped providing its financial support to 41 NGOs after the completion of the schools attuned by them due to their inefficiency and management problem. Now 284 NGOs are receiving full financial support from ESP for 2545 schools. Year wise increase of ESP partners and schools financed by ESP (ESP NFPE schools) is shown in table I below.

In addition, ESP provided material cost to one NGO named Unnayan Shahojogy Team (UST) for 56 schools and training cost to one NGO named Society for Project Implementation Research Evaluation and Training (SOPIRET) for 7 schools. Fifty six (56) partner NGOs provide the funding for their NFPE programs from their own sources. These NGOs pay for the technical supports provided by ESP.

Partners receiving financial support from BRAC's ESP

It is already mentioned that now ESP has been providing full financial support for 2545 NFPE schools to 284 partner NGOs. A few of these NGOs are based in Dhaka. Names of these NGOs, year of partnership, their NFPE locations, and the number of schools are shown in table 2.

Planning Association of Bangladesh (FPAB), Community Development Association (CDA), Jagrata Juba Sangha, Assistance for Social Organization and Development (ASOD), Bangladesh Nari Progoti Sangha, PROTISHSRUTI, Rangpur Unnayan Samajik Sangstha (RDSS), Socio-Economic Development Society, UTTARAN, Banchha Chai Samaj Unnayan Samity, Dula Jana Kalyan Sangstha, Sramajibi-O-Dustha Kalyan Sangstha (SDKS), Ghashful MCH FP & FW Association, Jhanjira Samaj Kalyan Sangstha (JSKS), Shishu Niloy (SN), Gana unn. kendra, SANGRAM, Gana Kalyan Kendra, Gani Unn. Kendra, Jana Kalyan Sangstha, PIPASA, Samaj Kalyan Sangstha, Samata Samaj Kalyan Samiti, and Utara Development Programme (UDP) have provided funding from their own sources respectively for 3, 30, 21, 59, 6, 155, 5, 15, 22, 30, 41, 5, 20, 35, 200, 13, 23, 5, 14, 31, 8, 35, 8, 8, 5, 8, 7.5, 8, and 9 (834 in total) NFPE schools. The NGOs received material and training supports from BRAC but they paid for that.

Criteria for selecting partner NGOs. To select a NGO as a partner for non-formal primary education (NFPE), Education Support Program (ESP) follows certain criteria. The criteria that are usually followed to select a NGO are stated below.

First, to be selected as a BRAC's ESP partner the NGO must be registered under the Social Welfare Department or Society Registration ACT or Women's Affairs Bureau of the People's Republic of Bangladesh. This is because to get registration a NGO has to fulfill certain conditions, viz., having a constitution congruence with the existing laws of Bangladesh, an executive committee consisting of distinguished honorable member of the community, having a systematic and incorrupt accounting system and the like, determined by the concern authority that may help good governance, transparency and financial discipline.

Second, an ESP partner NGO should be small and local working in an union, a thana or a district. On the average the existing ESP partner NGOs have only eight (8) permanent staffs and their average annual budget is less than Tk. 500000. Because most of the executive heads of these NGOs stay at their NFPE project areas and because they are not over burdened with other programs they take care of their NFPE program very seriously and intensively and also invest a lot of energy and efforts to make the program successful. Moreover, the executive heads of the NGOs, their NFPE Program Organizers and the members of the executive committee belong to same community they work with. This contributes to their success in solving the social problems efficiently. For example, from the very inception of ESP till now, no ESP funded NFPE school house has been burnt by the fundamentalists nor have they been able to close any school during the course.

Third, Education Support Program (ESP) provides financial support to the NGOs

which have little or no access to the donor agencies for funds. ESP does not provide financial support to the moneyed national or international NGOs. If any NGOs receiving financial support from ESP now can arrange funding for their NFPE program in future ESP will stop providing its financial support after the completion of one or two full NFPE cycle when they will acquire the necessary conceptual, human and technical skills to implement the program successfully.

Fourth, to be an ESP partner the NGO must be motivated to accept the whole NFPE model. This is because our observations shows that no NGO can run schools over a full course period successfully as per NFPE standard avoiding some of its ingredient(s).

Fifth, the NFPE village (s) proposed by the NGO must not coincide with that of BRAC's NFPE. Before submitting the "ORGANIZATION PROFILE" (developed by ESP) the NGO must take recommendation on it from the In-charge of the nearest BRAC's NFPE/RDP office. This is simply to avoid duplication and contradiction.

Sixth, the NFPE area proposed by the NGO should not be Dhaka city. This is because BRAC, PRSHIKA, Gana Shahajya Sangstha and some other big NGOs are implementing the children education program in Dhaka city.

Seventh, to be selected as an ESP partner the NGO should agree to accept the implementation and management strategies adopted by ESP.

Eighth, to be an ESP partner the NGO should have some experience in development activities and should have good economic habit

Ninth, for selecting partners for NFPE, ESP always gives preference for women headed NGOs. This is consistent to a major objective of ESP to ensure women's participation in the implementation and management of primary education program.

Last, the partner NGO must be secular and follow secular approach to development. BRAC is a secular organization and does have reverence for all human being. BRAC does not and should not work for the development of any particular religious community but to promote human dignity.

These are the criteria for selecting ESP partner NGOs for providing financial support in brief. The criteria are not rigid but are reasonably flexible. With the changes of contextual situation and experience these will be modified or changed in discussion with the partner NGOs and other important persons to make them more pragmatic, reasonable, and fair.

Partner not Receiving Financial Support from ESP

Fifty six (56) NGOs have been providing funding to their NFPE programs from their own sources. These NGOs buy BRAC materials (printed materials) and training. Names of the NGOs and the number of schools attuned by them are shown in table 3. (As these NGOs do not submit reports to ESP, the figures below may differ a little from the actual.)

THE ESP FINANCED SCHOOLS (ESP NFPE SCHOOLS)

Till April 1999, total number of schools financed by ESP (ESP NFPE schools) was 4860. Among these 4860 schools, 2315 schools had completed the three year course. One hundred twenty nine (129) completed the course in December 1994 (closed in January

1995), 234 in December 1995 (closed in January 1996), 85 in December 1996 (closed in January 1997), 937 in December 1997, and 930 schools completed the course in January 1999. Now BRAC's Education Support Program (ESP) is providing funding for 2545 NFPE schools administered by 284 partner NGOs. Among these 2545 schools, 940 schools are now in the first year or class-I, 1010 schools are in the second year or class-II, and 595 schools are in the third year or class-III. Total enrolment in these 2545 schools is 76350 with an average enrolment of 30. Fifty five thousand eight hundred and eighty eight (55888) or about 73 per cent of total students are girls. In the 940 class-I schools total enrolment is 28200, boys 7668 and girls 20532. In the 1010 class-II schools total enrolment is 30300, boys 8097 and girls 22203. And in the 595 class-III schools total enrolment is 17850, boys 4697 and girls 13153. Organization-wise lists of class-I, Class-II and class-III schools, students, and percentages of boys and girls are shown respectively in appendix A, B and C.

The children aged 8-10 years who have never been enrolled in school or are dropouts having no literacy or numeracy and belong to the poor and deprived families are selected to be enrolled in ESP NFPE schools. Sincere efforts are made to avoid children those who have learning disability during the selection period.

Average attendance in the ESP NFPE schools is 95 per cent. Students performance is satisfactory. Strategies that can likely ensure the learning for each and every child are carefully followed in ESP NFPE schools. The children learn what they are expected to learn. Cocurricular activities as singing, dancing, playing games and drama, story telling, drawing pictures and the like are regularly practiced in the ESP NFPE schools simultaneously with the curricular activities. Cocurricular activities along with the sympathetic and soft approach of teacher to the children make an ESP NFPE school enjoyable for them and prevent dropout. Till April 1999, it is reported that total number of dropout children in the ESP NFPE schools is 3 only.

In the ESP NFPE schools children are provided with the opportunity to use

exploratory language. In other words, children are allowed to talk into different problems in their own language in their own way without any intervention from the teacher. When they talk they think critically and try to build new knowledge. Teachers are equipped with the necessary knowledge, skills and attitude to facilitate the discussion following appropriate sequences and strategies. Discussion is carried on in open and collaborative approach. Cooperation among the children is preferred than competition.

Conscious and concentrated prolonged efforts are made by the teachers to develop positive self-concept of all the students in the ESP NFPE schools. Teachers try to provide all the students with success experience which excite motivation in them to learn more. Teacher takes care of all the students, not of a chosen few. In the ESP NFPE schools, no one is nobody, everyone is somebody.

For enhancing and ensuring the learning of all the children in ESP NFPE schools, teachers evaluate their achievement at the completion of each phase of instruction. If majority of the students fail to attain the objective (s), the subject matter related to that objective (s) is retaught. If a few students fail to attain any objective (s), the teacher arranges peer tutoring and/or tutoring by him/herself. Moreover, they are provided with more opportunities to participate in the class activities. Summative evaluation of students achievement also occurs after the completion of each year's courses to help them prepare for the formal system. Formative tests are constructed by teachers and summative tests are supplied by ESP.

There is one teacher for each of the on-going 2545 schools. Two thousand five hundred and thirty four (2534) or more than 99 percent of teachers are female and 1882 or 74 percent of total number of teachers have passed Secondary School Certificate examination. Teachers in ESP NFPE schools (organization-wise) along with sex, academic qualification, and marital status are shown in Appendix D.

The ESP NFPE school houses look like NFPE school houses. For an ESP NFPE school house, a rent of Tk.150 is paid to the house owner a month.

Community participation is much valued in ESP NFPE. The ESP' partners realize that for the successful implementation of ESP NFPE program community participation is critical. Importance is given to make the community participate in the planning, implementation and management of the program. Their opinion about the quality of the education provided is honored. Parents are also encourage to bear a portion of the cost of the program which is within the limit of their capacity. For example, the parents bear the cost of the exercise book that their children need to write Bengali, English and diary in class-II and Class-III. Parents of the children bear the cost of printing questions for summative testing. They also pay for the school mats and slates that their children need for the second or third time.

The schools completed the three year course

Two thousand three hundred fifteen (2315) ESP NFPE schools had so far completed the three year course, 129 schools in December 1994, 234 in December 1995, and 85 schools in December 1996, 937 in 1997, and 930 in January 1999.

Total enrolment in the schools completed the course in December 1994 was 3870. One thousand forty eight (1048) students or 27 per cent of total enrolment were boys and 2822 or 73 per cent of total enrolment were girls. Three thousand eight hundred and eight (3808) students or 98.39 per cent of total students completed the three year course. Total dropouts were 62 or 1.61 per cent. Three thousand six hundred and sixty two (3662) students or 96 per cent of the students who completed the course were admitted into primary or secondary schools; 2625 in class four, 925 in class five, and 112 in class six.

Total enrolment in the schools completed the course in December 1995 was 7020. Six thousand nine hundred thirty nine (6939) or 98.80 per cent completed the course. Among the 6939 children who completed the three year course, 6627 or 95.5 per cent were admitted into govt. primary or secondary schools. Four thousand five hundred fifty eight (4558) or 66 per cent of the students completed the course were admitted in class four,

1717 or 25 per cent were admitted in class five and 352 or 5 per cent were admitted in class six.

Total enrolment in the schools completed the course in December 1996 was 2550. Seven hundred sixty three (763) or 30 per cent of total enrolment were boys and 1787 or 70 per cent of total enrolment were girls. Two thousand five hundred and forty three (2543) students or 99.73 per cent of total students completed the three year course. Total dropouts were 7 or 0.27 per cent. Two thousand four hundred and fifty six (2456) students or 96.57 per cent of the students who completed the course were admitted into primary or secondary schools; 1763 in class four, 596 in class five, and 95 in class six.

Enrolment in the schools completed the course in 1997 was 28110. Twenty eight thousand and sixty nine (28069) or 99 per cent completed the course. Among the 28069 children who completed the three year course, 27576 or 98 per cent were admitted into govt. primary or secondary schools. Eighteen thousand and forty seven (18047) or 64 per cent of the students completed the course were admitted in class four, 8017 or 28 per cent were admitted in class five and 1512 or 8 per cent were admitted in class six.

Total enrolment in the schools completed the course in January 1999 was 27900. Twenty seven thousand eight hundred seventy nine (27879) or 99 per cent completed the course. Among the 27879 children who completed the three year course, 27458 or 98 per cent were admitted into govt. primary or secondary schools. Eighteen thousand two hundred thirty nine (18239) or 65 per cent of the students completed the course were admitted in class four, 6764 or 24 per cent were admitted in class five and 2455 or 11 per cent were admitted in class six.

Number of schools that completed the three year course in 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, and 1999 along with total enrolment, number of students who completed the three year course, and number of students admitted into primary or secondary schools are shown (year wise) in table 4.

IMPLEMENTATION AND MANAGEMENT OF ESP PROJECTS

The most important feature of ESP management is that ESP gets the work done through others. ESP implements its projects through partner NGOs. The Program Manager of ESP is entrusted with the responsibilities of the projects within the present administrative structure of BRAC. Twenty nine experienced Program Organizer-Technical Support Specialists (PO-TSSs) have been deployed to assist the Program Manager. The organogram of ESP is given in appendix E.

To implement ESP projects, the following strategies are followed.

Before starting operations at the field level, a 2-day orientation program on NFPE and ESP is organized by ESP for the partner NGO heads. The aim of the program is to make the participants realize that the successful replication of BRAC model NFPE by other NGOs will help achieve the national goal to eradicate illiteracy from Bangladesh. ESP firmly believes that for the successful replication of NFPE the heads of the partner NGOs

must appreciate the program design and should have positive attitude toward NFPE and ESP. The project budget, process and pattern of providing support to partner NGOs by ESP, the authority and responsibilities of partner NGOs are discussed in detail. If a common understanding is reached an agreement between BRAC and each partner NGO is signed for the proposed project stating the terms and conditions that both the parties are supposed to obey. For enhancing capacity of the NGO heads to manage the ESP NFPE program successfully and to obtain their feed back on ESP a 1-day discussion meeting for them is usually organized by ESP every year. Moreover, each NGO head is provided with a manual titled "WHAT NGO HEADS SHOULD DO FOR THE SMOOTH RUNNING OF NFPE PROGRAM." They are also provided with a brief report on Education Support Program (ESP) every year.

For the implementation and management of the NFPE program, each of partner organizations has its own Program Organizer (s). Many Program Organizers are Graduates or hold a masters degree.

Program Organizers of partner NGOs are responsible for all field level activities. The main activities the POs of partner NGOs are supposed to do are: 1) selection of school village, 2) selection of potential teachers, 3) arranging school houses, 4) selection of learners, 5) collection and distribution of materials, 6) ensuring the proper utilization of materials, 7) ensuring community participation, 8) maintaining liaison with important persons, 9) organizing and sending the teachers to BRAC's Training and Resource Centre (s) (TARCs) for training on time, 10) collection of information, preparation and submission of reports, 11) school supervision, 12) organization and facilitation of in-service teacher training courses, 13) organization and facilitation monthly parents meeting, 14) ensuring students attendace, 15) prevention of students dropouts, 16) deployment and development of alternative teachers, 17) ensuring admission of the children into primary or secondary schools who complete the NFPE course, 18) maintenance of registers and accounts, 19) preparation and submission of six monthly stock and financial statement,

and 20) preparation of Gantt chart and weekly action plan.

ESP provides training to the Program Organizers (POs) and teachers of partner NGOs. The training that are provided to the Program Organizers successively at different points of time are- (a) 4-day training on school organization intended to provide the POs with the necessary understanding and ability to perform school organizing activities efficiently. Four-day training is provided before starting operational activities, (b) 12-day NFPE teacher training aimed at equipping them with needed knowledge, skills, and attitude to perform the act of classroom teaching, (c) 6-day training on classroom management and instructional strategies to enable them to provide proper guidance for classroom instruction and classroom management to the teachers and to do other supervisory and managerial activities, (d) 10-day training of trainer (TOT) with the aim of developing the capacity of the POs to develop training modules and to facilitate teacher training courses, and (e) in-service practical training on maintenance of accounts and registers, writing reports, and preparation of six monthly stock and financial statements. Teacher training includes (a) 12-day basic training, (b) 2- day orientation held at just before the opening of schools to help the teachers remember the 12-day training, (c) 1-day monthly refresher through out the whole course, and (d) 4- day refresher held at the completion of first year's course. The orientation and refresher courses for teachers are held at the field offices of the concerned partner NGOs. Before receiving 12-day teacher training no NGO is provided with NFPE materials (printed).

Selection of NFPE village, children selection, teacher selection, arrangement of school accommodation, organization of parents, organization and facilitation of teacher refresher courses, school supervision, and other activities are performed by POs of partner NGOs in consultation with the PO-TSSs of ESP and their respective supervisors in their own organizations and on the basis of guidelines provided by them.

POs of partner NGOs are accountable to the respective supervisors of their own organizations. But they submit weekly and monthly reports on the progress of project

activities to ESP PO-TSSs and/or to the Program Manager of ESP.

The POs of partner NGOs usually visit each school twice a week. During the visit they carefully observe the progress of school activities and provide suggestions to the teachers to improve instructional strategies and classroom management.

POs of partner NGOs submit weekly and monthly school visit reports, and the reports on the monthly teachers refreshers and monthly parents meeting, quarterly report on student dropout, and six monthly stock and financial statements to ESP PO-TSSs and/or to the Program Manager of ESP. These reports are submitted regularly throughout the whole project period. In addition, the POs of partner organizations submit lists of selected children, bio-data of selected teachers, school opening reports, list of parents and some other reports usually once for a project. Oftentimes they are also asked by ESP to submit reports containing information about ESP NFPE schools. The POs submit all these reports to their respective supervisors too. ESP people carefully check, analyze and consolidate the necessary information, and provide feedback on these reports to appropriate persons.

ESP PO-TSSs visit the partner NGOs and their schools usually once in a month. They check the validity of the reports and provide feedback on the progress of the project activities to POs of partner NGOs and NGO heads and suggest measures to improve the quality of the program. During their visit, they carefully observe various aspects of man, material, and money management, school activities, student achievement, and others and collect information needed to prepare a report in the format titled "MONITORING OF NFPE UNDERTAKEN BY PARTNER ORGANIZATION" (Appendix F) and developed by ESP. The form contains 35 items to be ranked on a five-point rating scale. ESP PO-TSSs are equipped with the necessary knowledge, skills, and attitude to rank the items objectively.

ESP PO-TSSs submit the monthly monitoring reports on NFPE attuned by the partner NGOs to Program Manager of ESP in each month while they come to head office to attend the monthly staff meeting.

Two hundred eighty four (284) NGOs are now receiving supervision and monitoring services from ESP. Considering the NFPE locations of the partner NGOs ESP has divided them into 29 areas. Twenty nine ESP PO-TSSs are working as In-charges of these 29 areas. Most of them are based at BRAC's field offices.

The Program Manager of ESP also visits the partner NGOs and their schools time to time. He provides feedback to POs of partner NGOs, heads of the partner NGOs, and to ESP POs-TSSs. He also suggests or takes measures to maintain or to improve the quality of the project.

ESP provides financial supports to the partner NGOs in goods, services, and money. Goods are provided in three instalments. Each instalment covers the requirements of one year. Money is provided in six instalments. This has been proved to be an effective strategies to minimize BRAC's cost and to check wastage and misappropriation.

The partner NGOs are responsible for the proper utilization of NFPE materials provided by BRAC. For NFPE each NGO maintains a stock register and preserves the supporting challans. Receipt/expenditure statement and the stock statement are submitted to BRAC's ESP every six months.

The NGOs are supposed to prepare the statement of accounts in such a manner as to make it possible to ascertain that the funds received from BRAC for their NFPE project (s) are utilized properly. The accounts should tally with individual items of accounts listed in the project(s) budget. Accounts vouchers and all other documents should be preserved very carefully.

COST OF ESP NFPE

ESP is now providing full financial support to 284 NGOs for 2545 NFPE schools. Estimated total cost of these 2545 schools for three years is Taka 159207565 which includes the amount for ESP's consultancy, monitoring, and supervision services. Depending on contextual situation, cost per school differs from project to project. On the average, estimated cost for three years is Taka 62557 a school and cost per child per year is Taka 695 or US 14.33 dollars.

CONCLUDING REMARKS

ESP has been working for the last nine years. Now it is proved that partnership for non-formal primary education among non-government organizations (NGOs) in Bangladesh can work effectively and efficiently. ESP has provided financial as well as technical support to 325 NGOs for 4860 schools. Among these 4860 schools, 2315 schools have completed the three year course, 940 schools are now running class-I, 1010 schools are now running class-II, and 595 schools are now running class-III. Average attendance of students in the ESP NFPE schools is 95 per cent. Students achievement is satisfactory. In the ESP NFPE schools, the teachers follow instructional strategies that likely ensure the learning for each and every child. ESP always tries to design the classroom instruction by simultaneously considering alternative inputs and processes or the means by which educational inputs are transformed into educational outputs (cognitive achievement, skill development, attitudinal changes, and behavioral changes). Perhaps, a good interaction of inputs and process contributes significantly to the economy of teaching in the ESP NFPE schools. Hence ESP NFPE is effective and efficient both technologically and economically. Actual cost could be reduced remarkably if ESP could open more schools through the existing partners because no more ESP staff will be required to provide the monitoring, consultancy, and supervision services for these schools. Forming partnership with new NGOs is also needed. Hundreds of NGOs from different corners of Bangladesh have been persistently showing their interest to work on partnership with BRAC's ESP and, as our experience says, if they are given the opportunity they will efficiently be contributing to the eradication of illiteracy from Bangladesh. Considering the above realities ESP desires to extend its support to the existing as well as to the new partners. Efforts of the partners, not receiving financial support from BRAC, toward the eradication of illiteracy from Bangladesh is also praise worthy. ESP is keen to provide them with every kind of technical support possible.

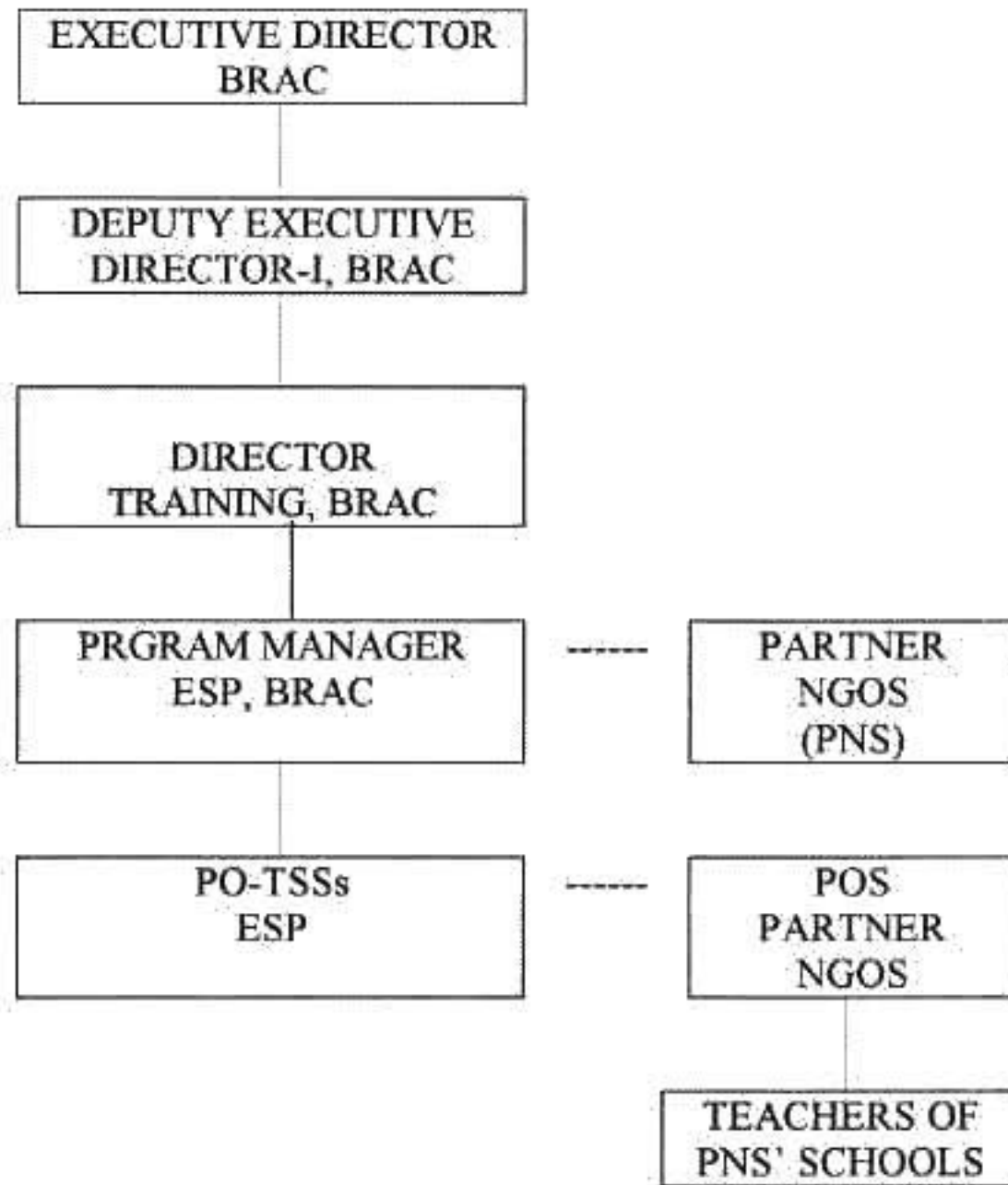
