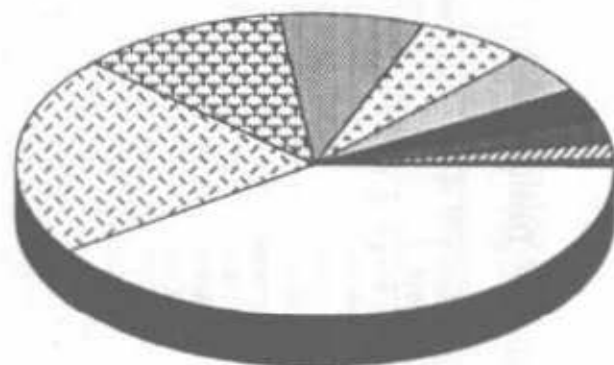

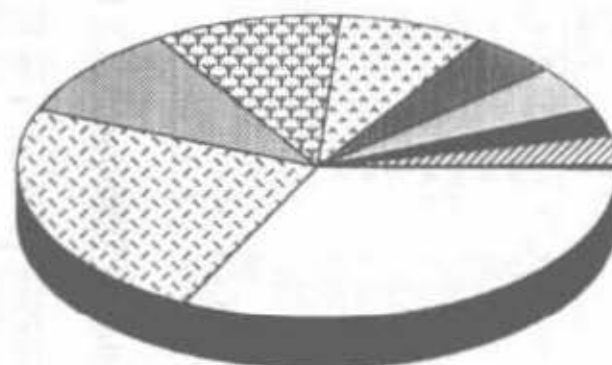
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**Sectorwise Distribution of Disbursement and Outstanding : RCP + RDP
