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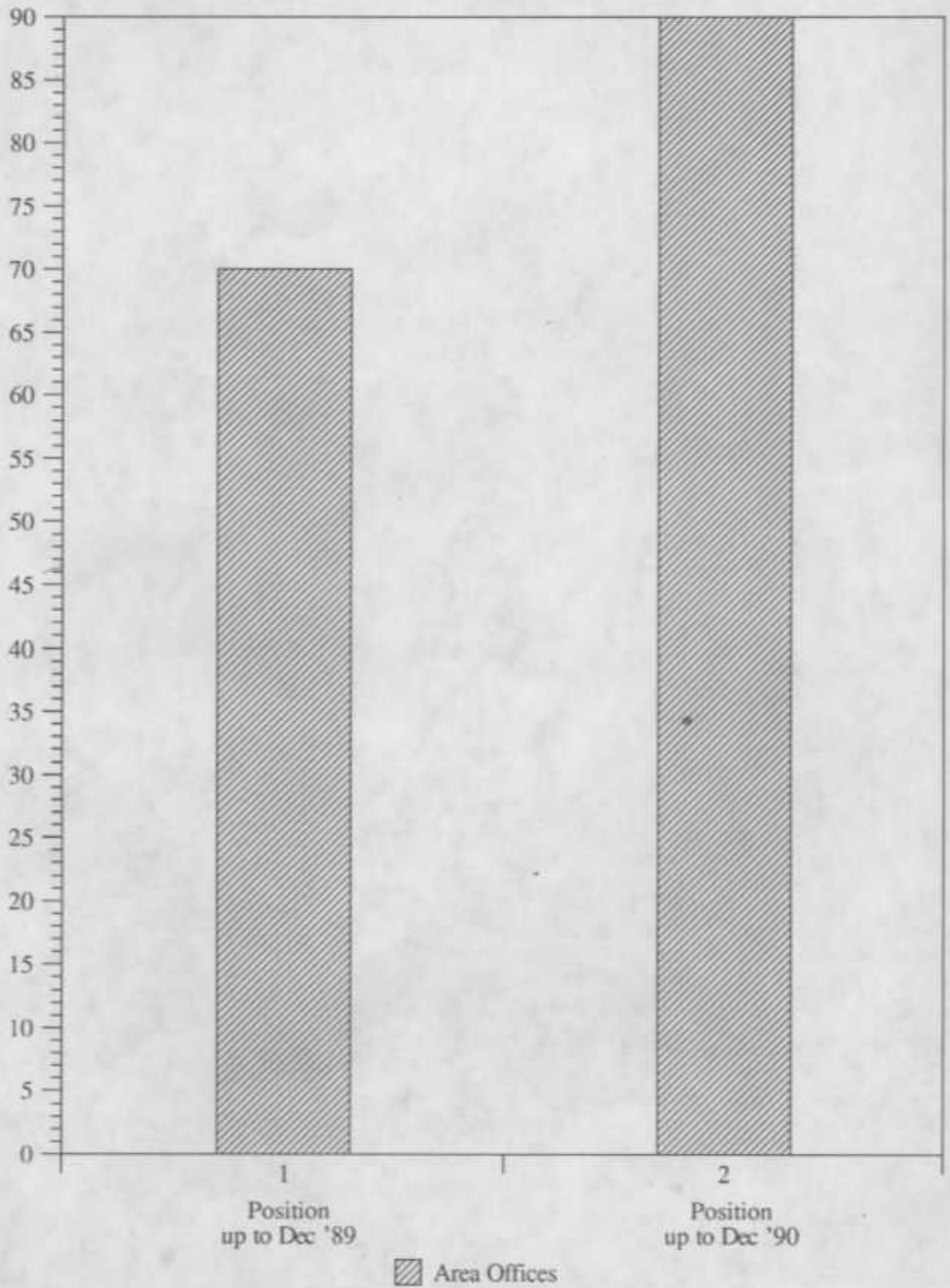

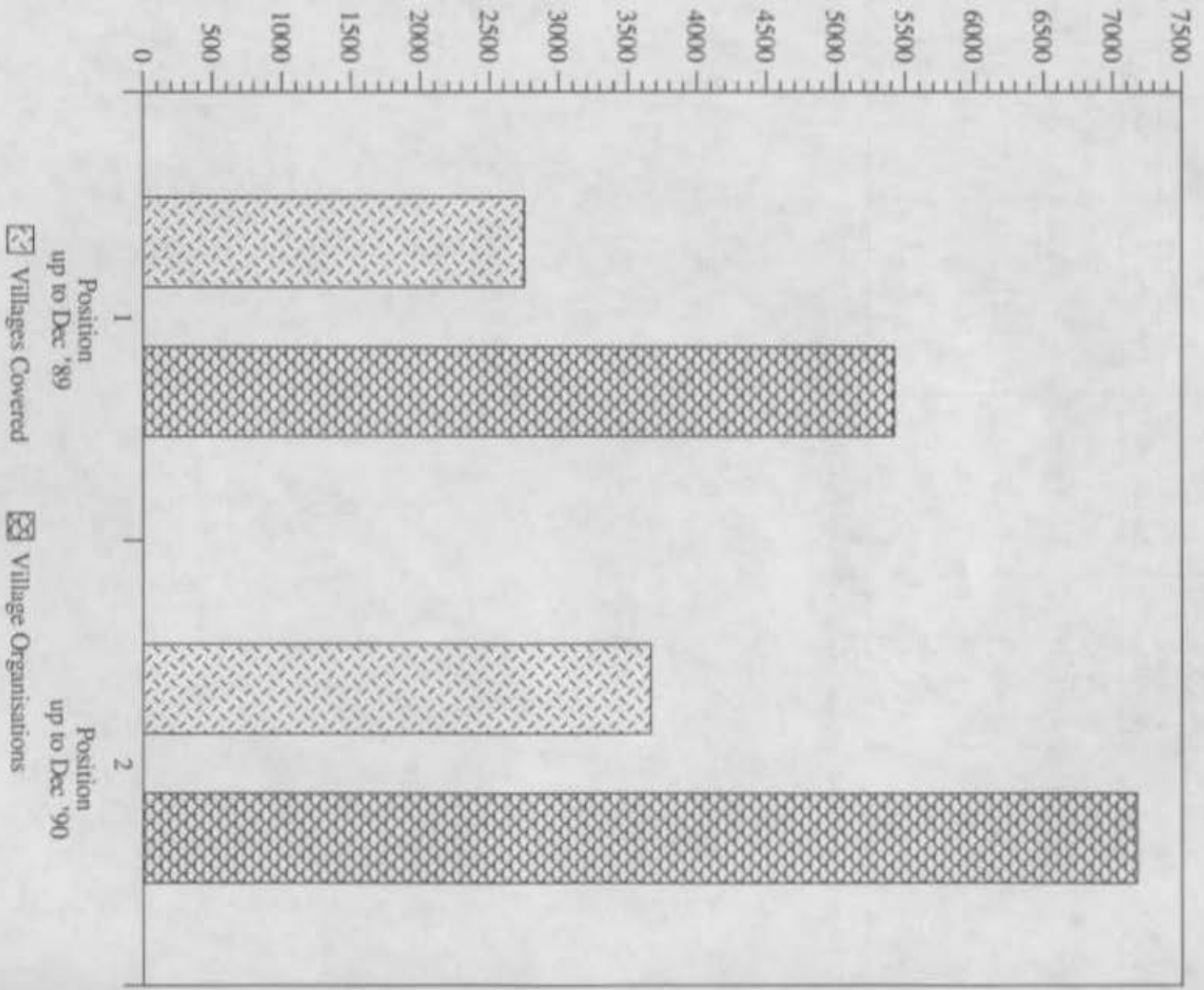

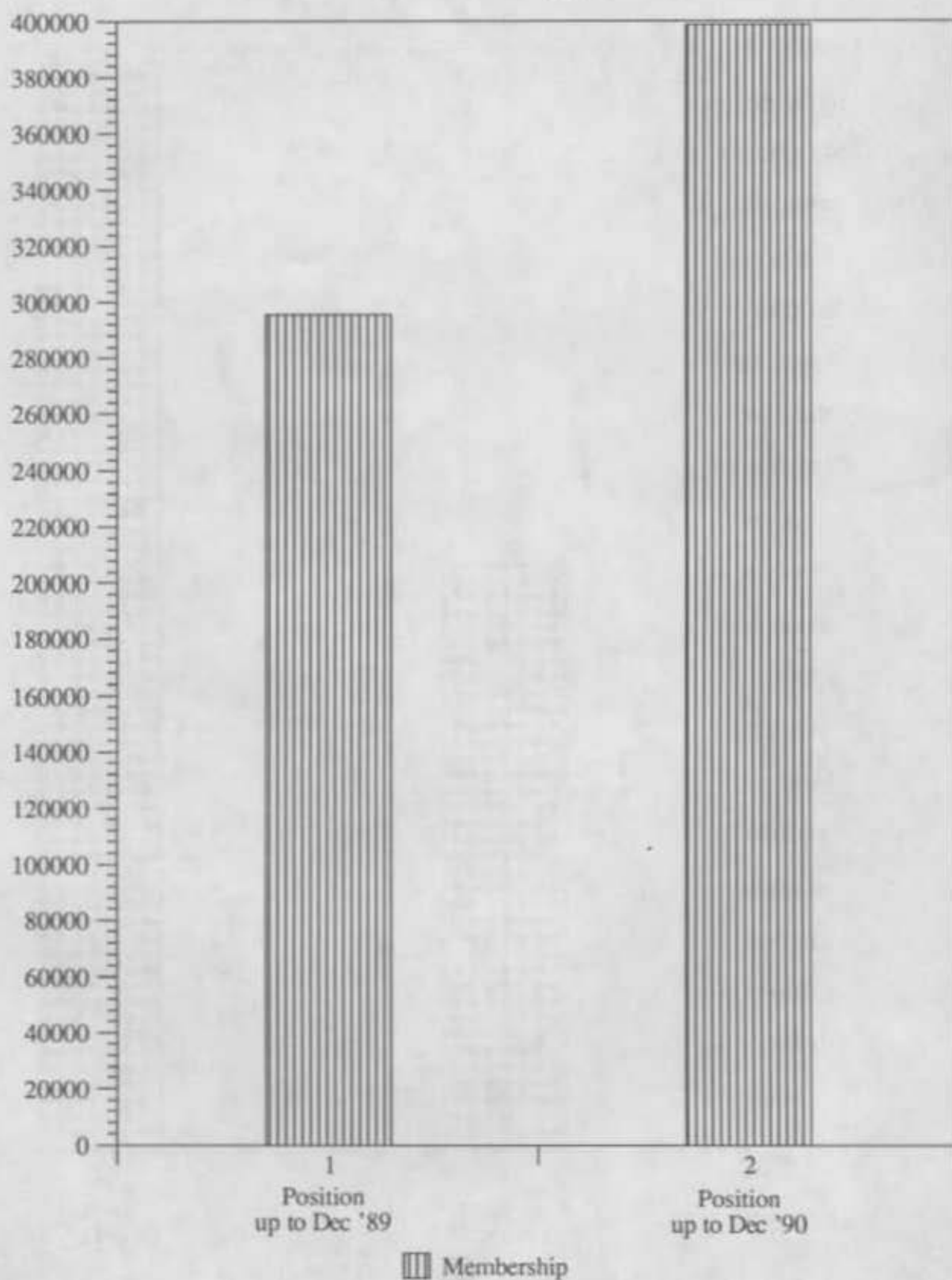

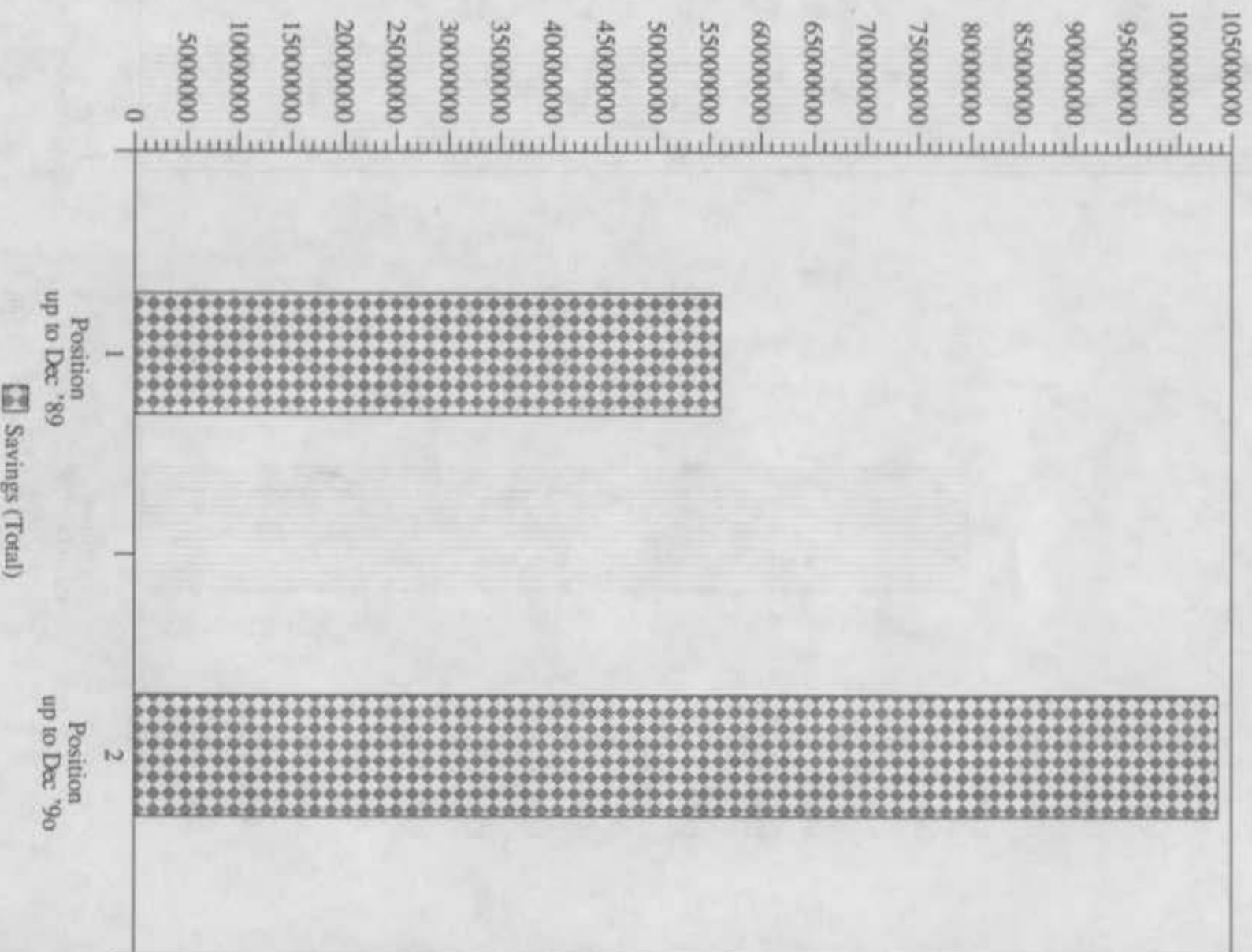
Graph 2 : VILLAGES AND VILLAGE ORGANISATIONS

R.D.P.

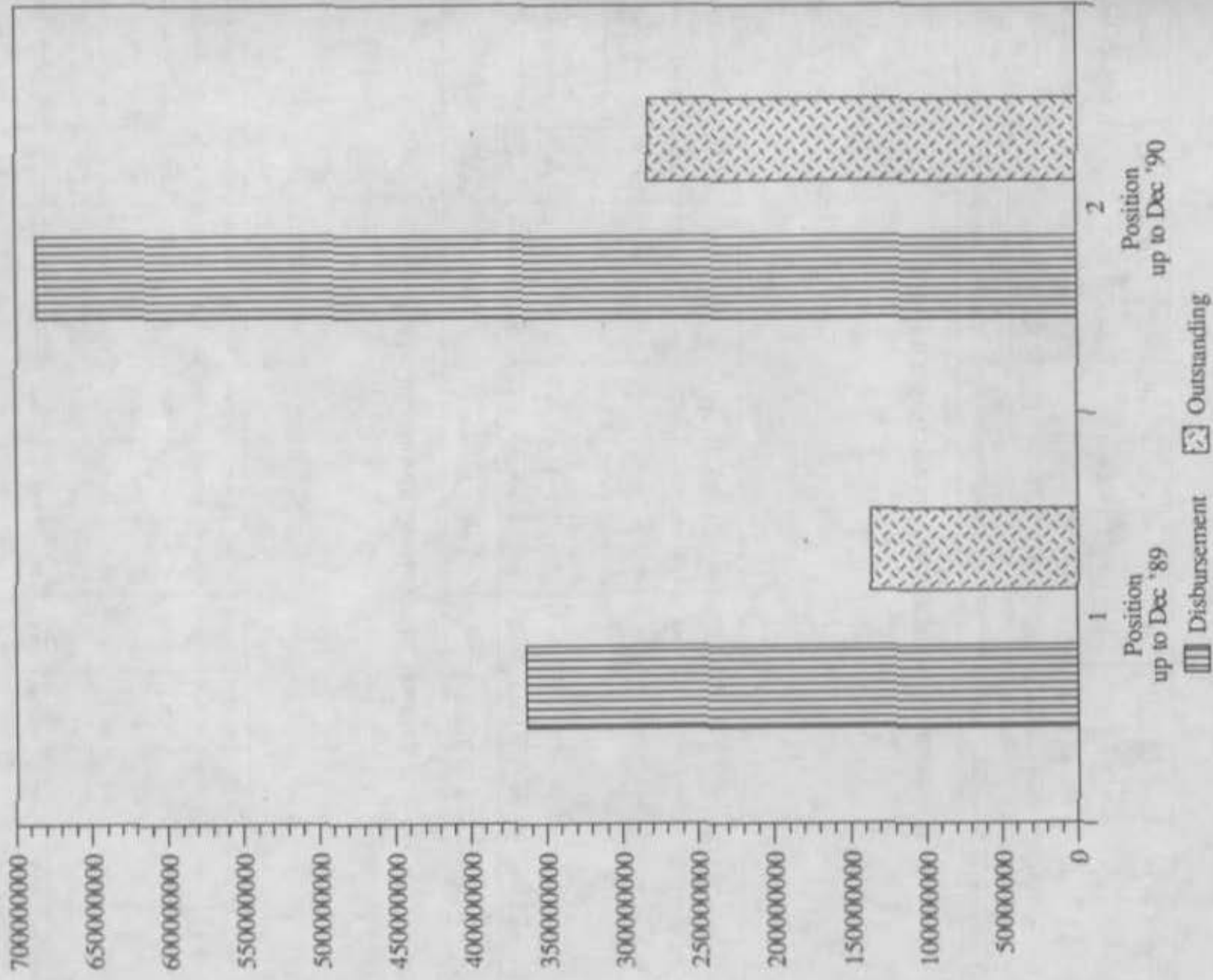

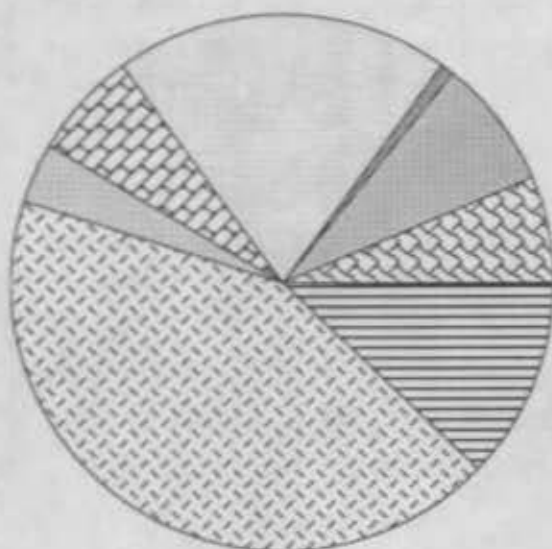

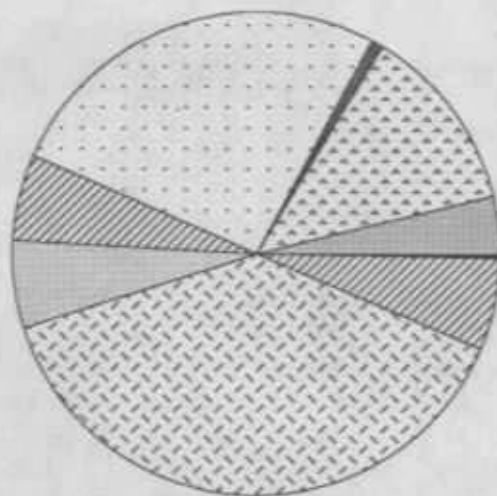

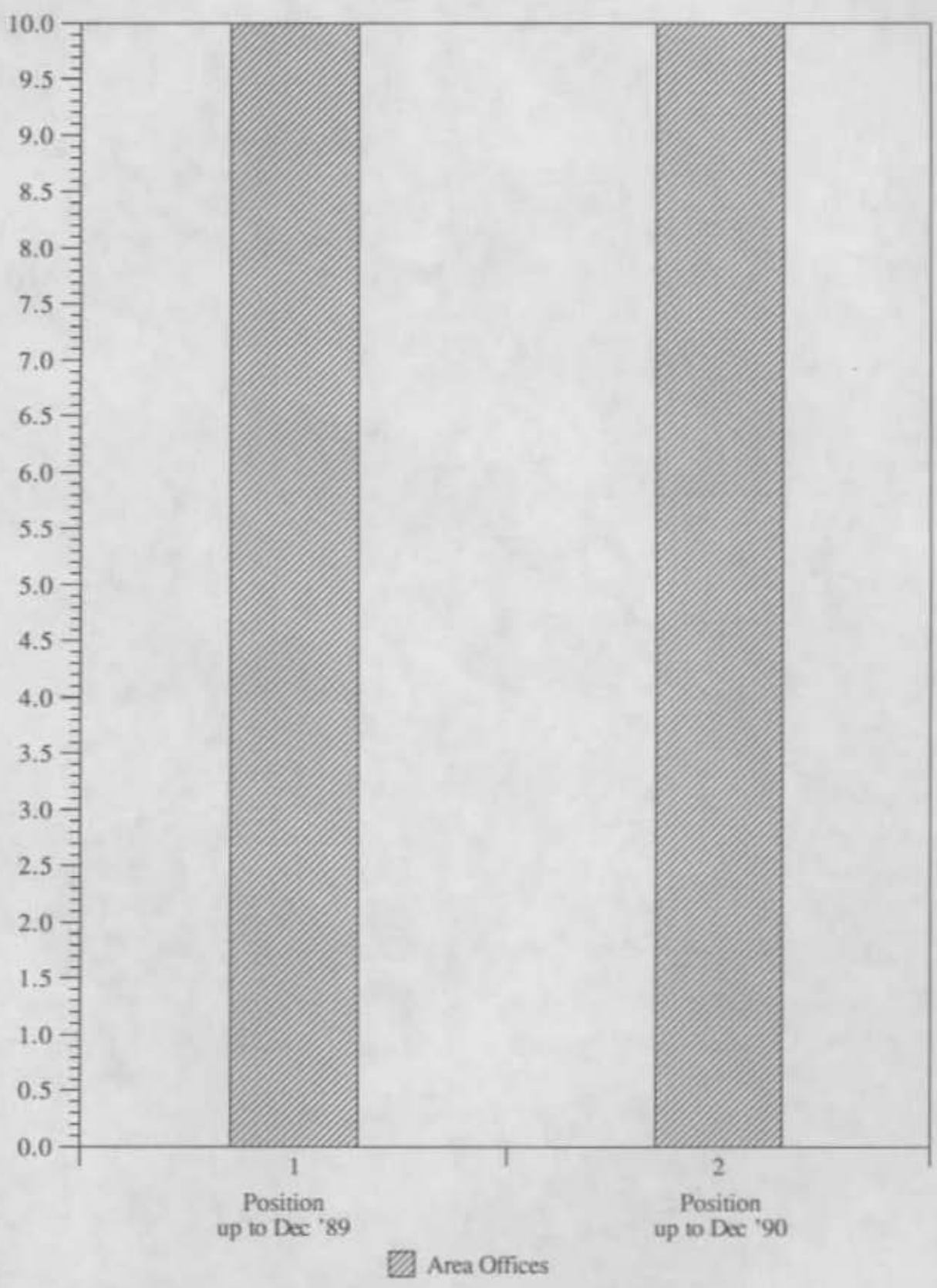

Graph 1 : AREA OFFICE

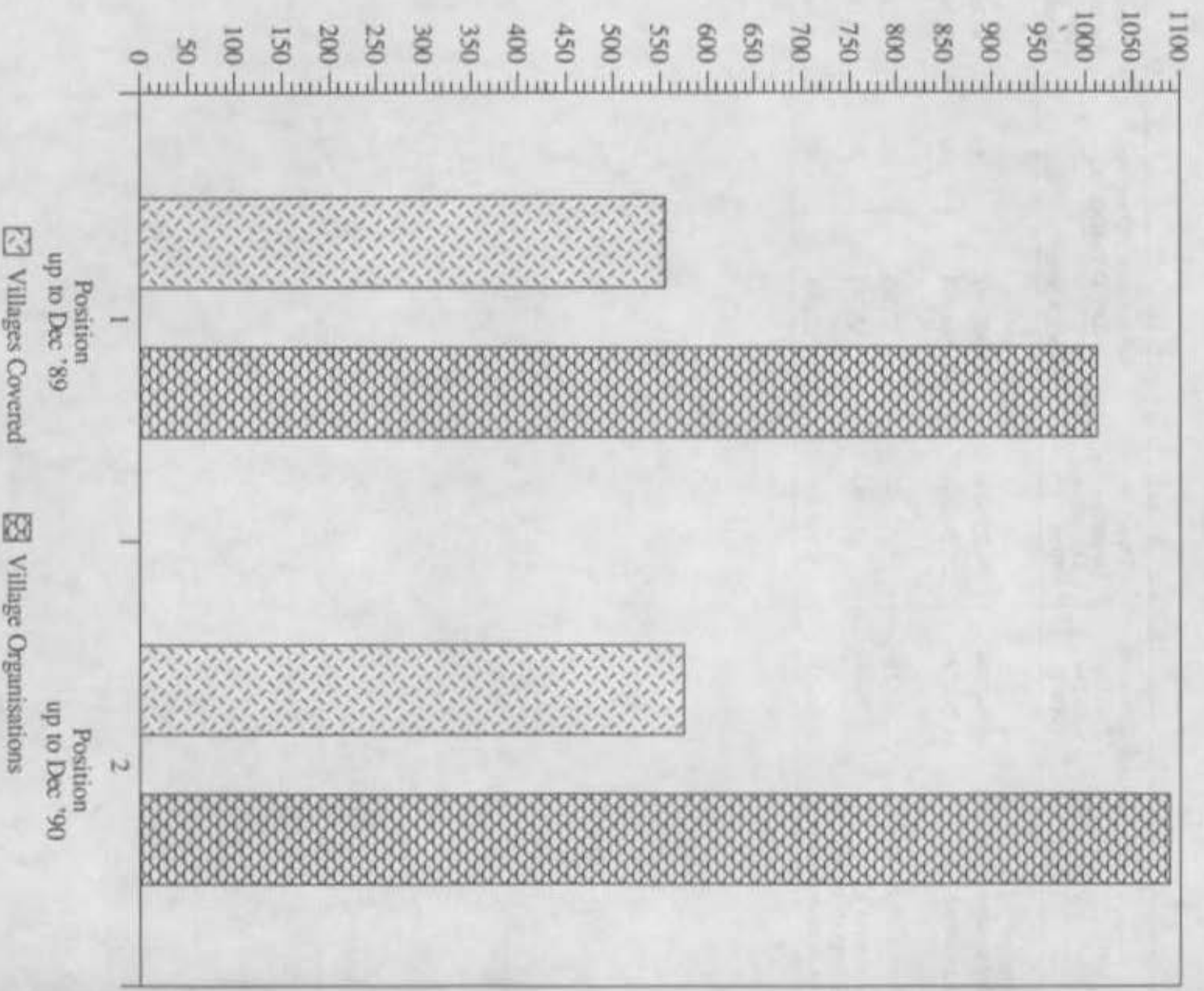

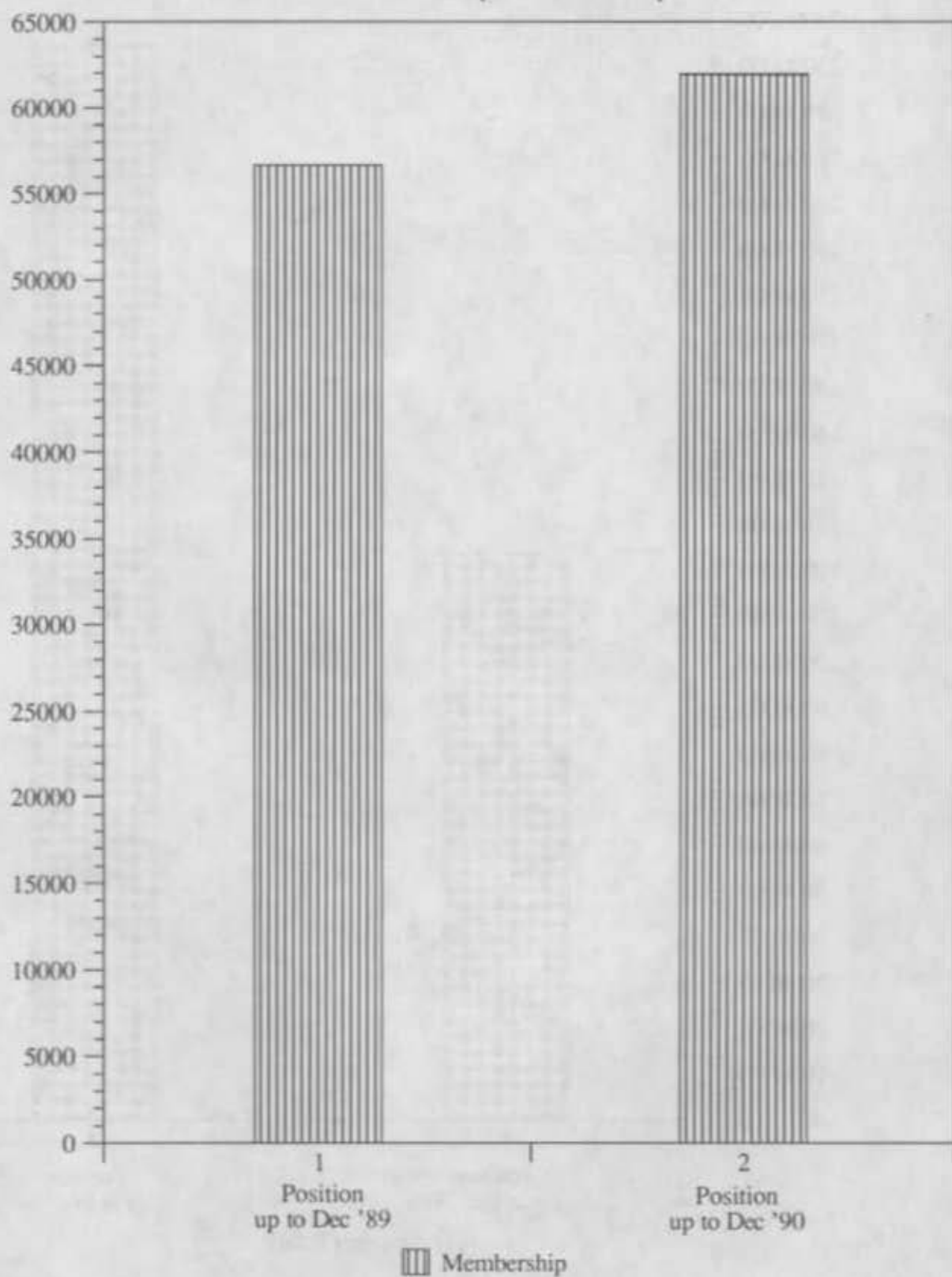

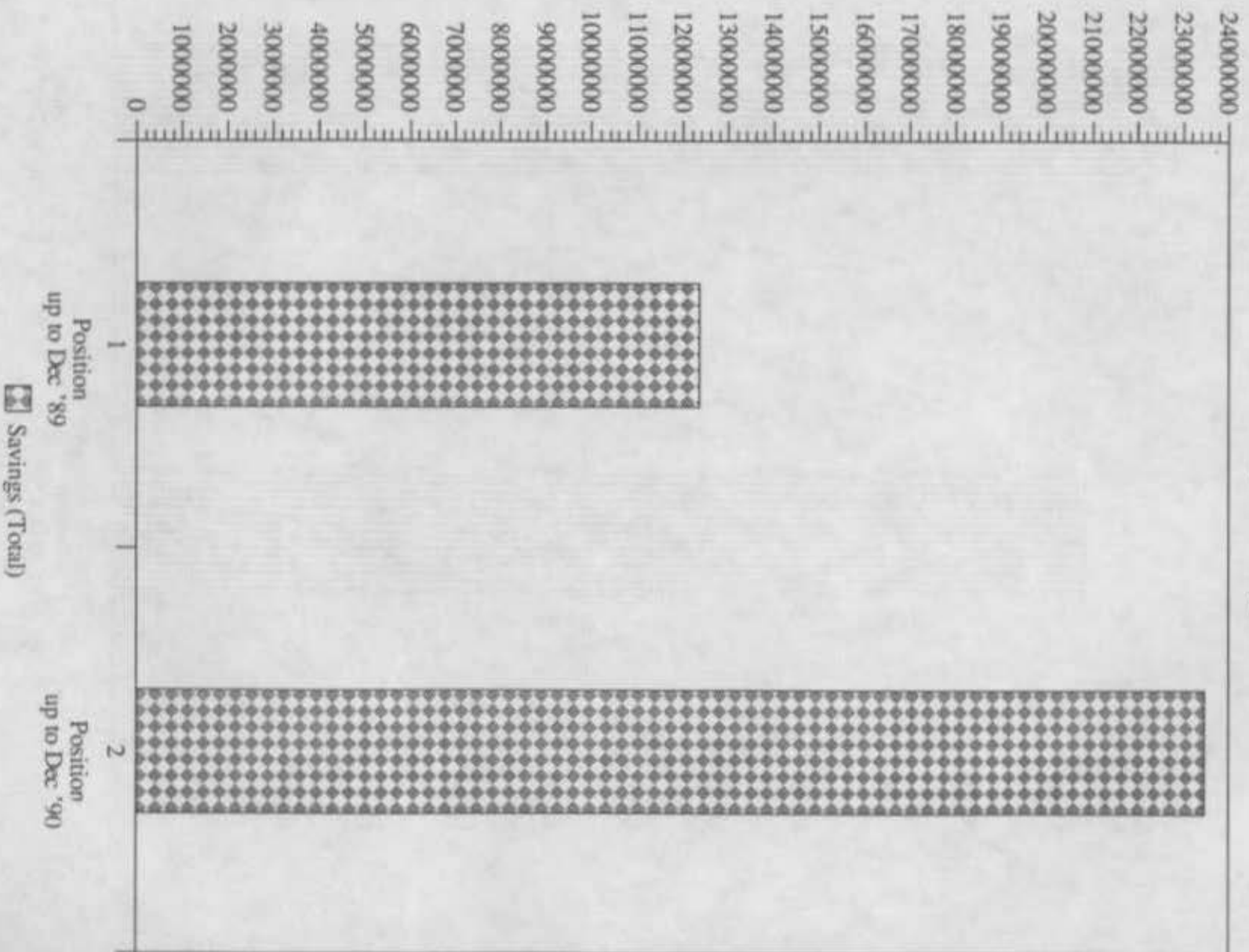
Graph 2 : VILLAGES AND VILLAGE ORGANISATIONS



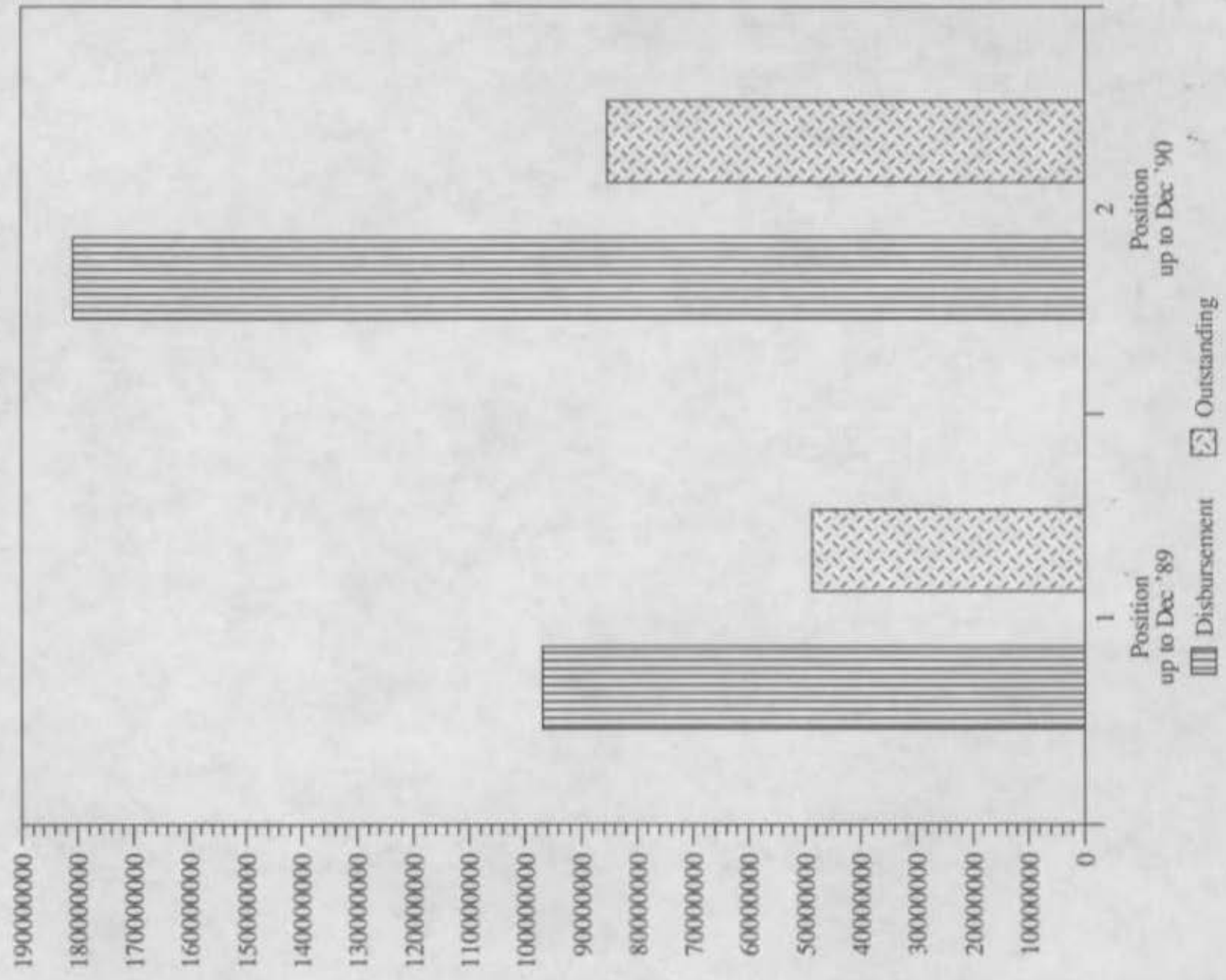
Graph 3 : Membership

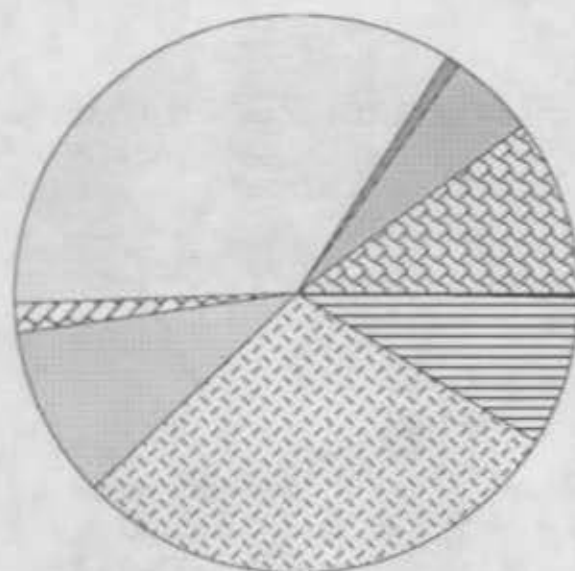

Chart 1 : SECTORWISE DISTRIBUTION OF DISBUREMENT













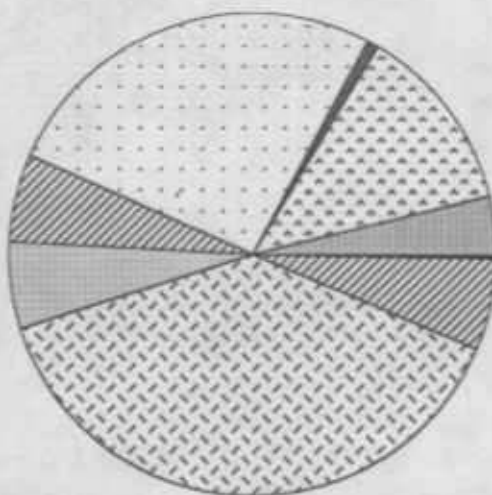
