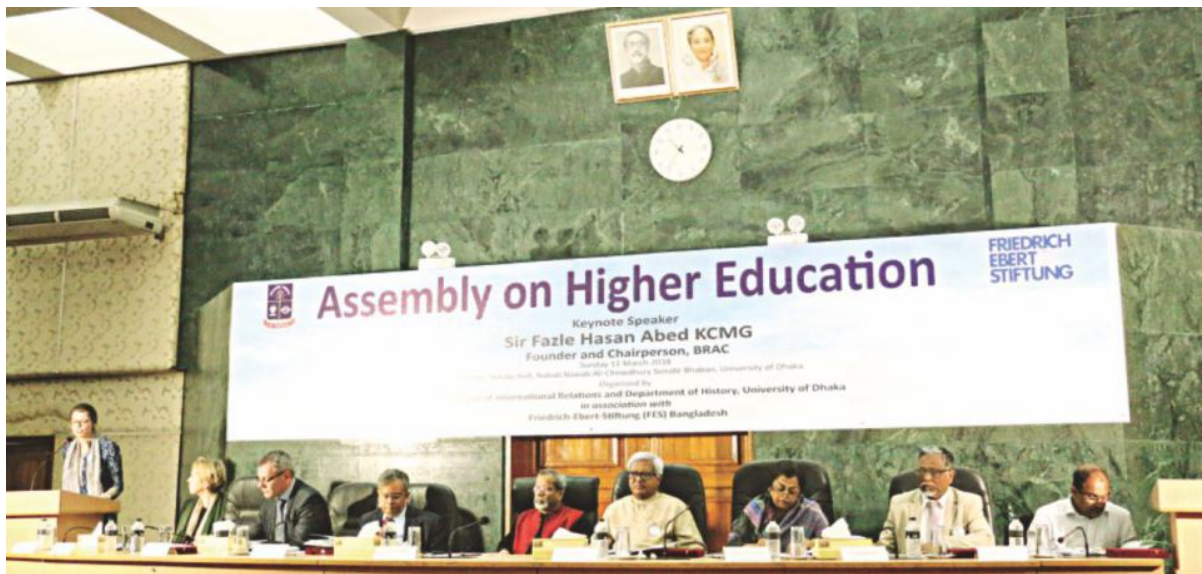

Sir Fazle Hasan Abed KCMG advises to focus on higher education
