Workshop on national budget held at BRAC university

A day long workshop on National Budget and Accountability held at BRAC University on Saturday organised by Oikos Dhaka, a student body of BRAC University supported by PROGOTI and USAID. Dr. Akbar Ali khan, former advisor of the Bangladesh government, was the guest of honor while Md. Golam Samdani Fakir, Pro-VC of BRAC University, Registrar Ishfaq Ilahi Choudhury, Professor Dr. Enamul Haque of Economics Department, United International University; Dr. Taibur Rahman, professor, department of development studies, Dhaka University were present at the workshop.
