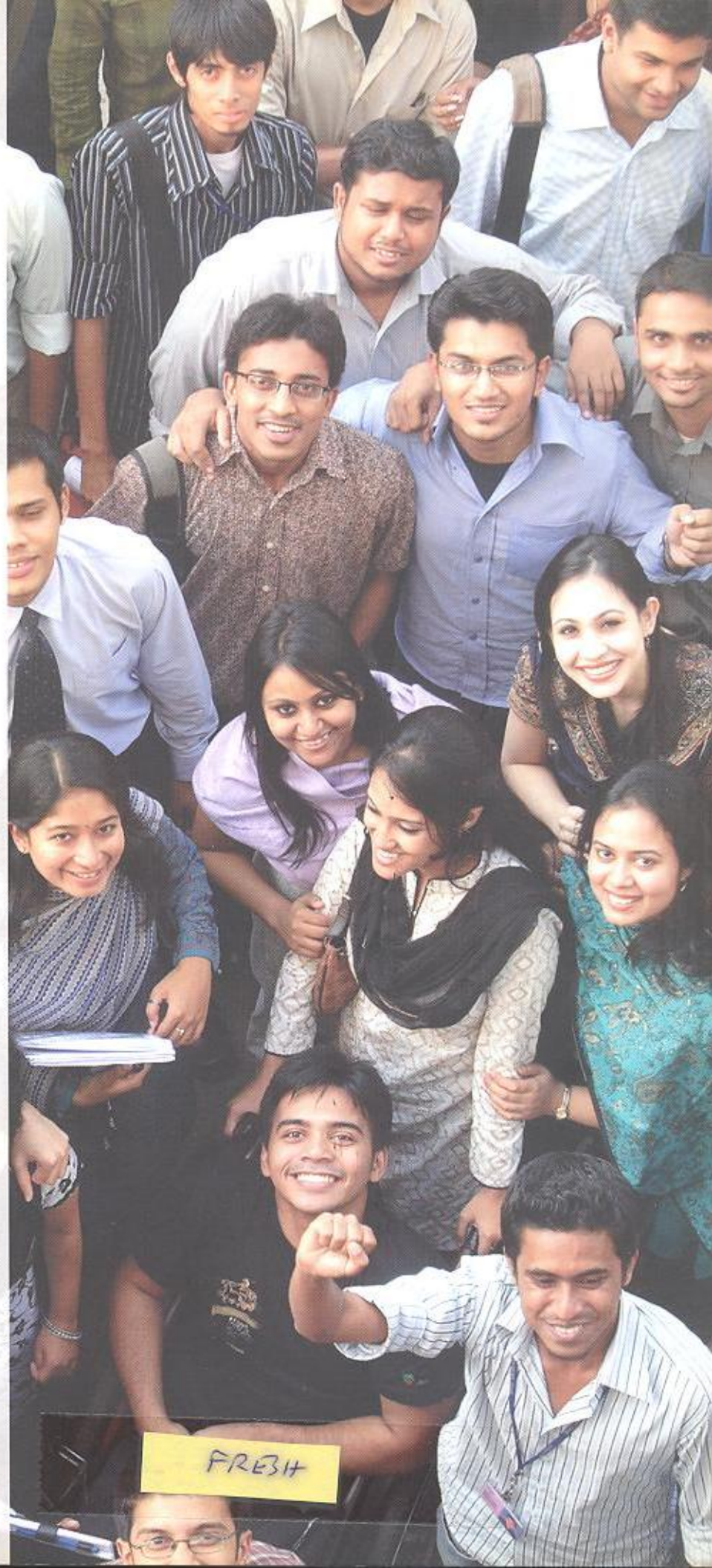

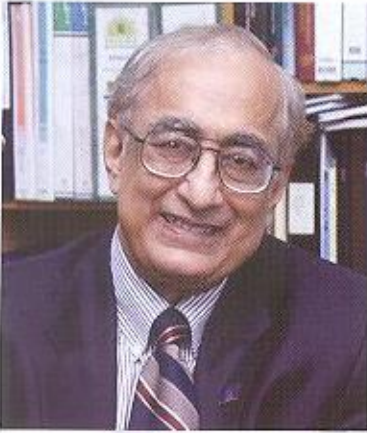

The main campus is located in Mohakhali, Dhaka in a six-storied Building, which is owned by BRAC University, and the residential campus is located at TARC, Savar. Over the span of four years the campus has expanded to four different buildings, which are all in close proximity to each other. There are approximately 3157 undergraduate students and 735 graduate students. The female to male ratio this year is 35:65.

BRACU strives to achieve the highest level of academic excellence and to recruit a diverse student population. In the year 2007, the university showed its commitment to students from underprivileged backgrounds, by disbursing a total of Taka 3,29,75,912 in scholarships and tuition fee waivers.

BRACU is significantly engaged in the 'Crossroads' progression, with the establishment of an MS in Biotechnology and MS in Applied Economics. In addressing the need for ongoing research, The Center for Research on Bangla Language Processing (CRBLP) was inaugurated.

Why are we unique?

There is nothing quite like BRACU! Each semester a diverse group of students comes together to experience an academic program that is different from any other in Bangladesh. The following are a few of the elements that make BRACU so special.

El Pro

In 2005, the English Language Programme was created to improve the English Language skills of the BRAC University students. The goal of El-Pro is to assist the students in developing the language skills that they need to be successful in graduate school or their professional life. El-Pro does this by using learner centered and creative language learning techniques and by developing modules based on students' skill level. This eliminates not only the possibility of having mixed ability classes, where some students flourish and some fail, but it also ensures small classes with excellent interaction between the teacher and learners. In addition to the university classes, El-Pro offers pre-university classes, for students who need extra help with their language skills, before they can be successful university students.

El-Pro realizes that language learning takes place outside the classroom, with social interaction. Hence it has initiated and participated in extra-curricular activities at the university's residential campus in Savar. These activities develop the students' creative abilities and assist in their language fluency. El-Pro views each student as a complete person and equips them with essential language skills and with important personal qualities to make their academic and professional life a fulfilling experience.



Residential Semester

The Residential Semester at Training and Resource Centre (TARC), Savar can be considered the flagship of the university. This program is the only one of its kind among all the private universities in the country. The students live and study as a group to develop both their academic and social skills.

A primary focus of the program is the enhancement of communication skills, especially in English. Students are motivated by various exercises and activities that help them to develop both leadership and team work competencies, so that they grow as an individual and as a member of the community.

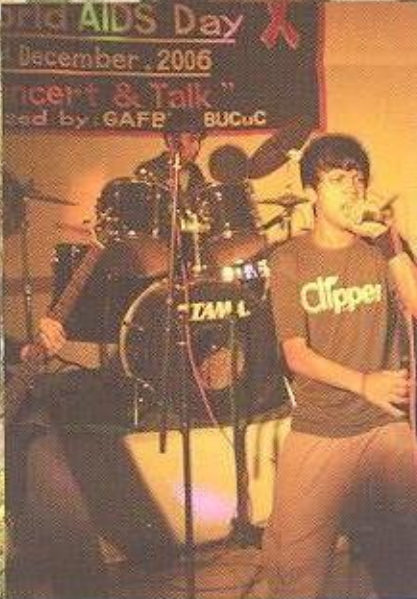
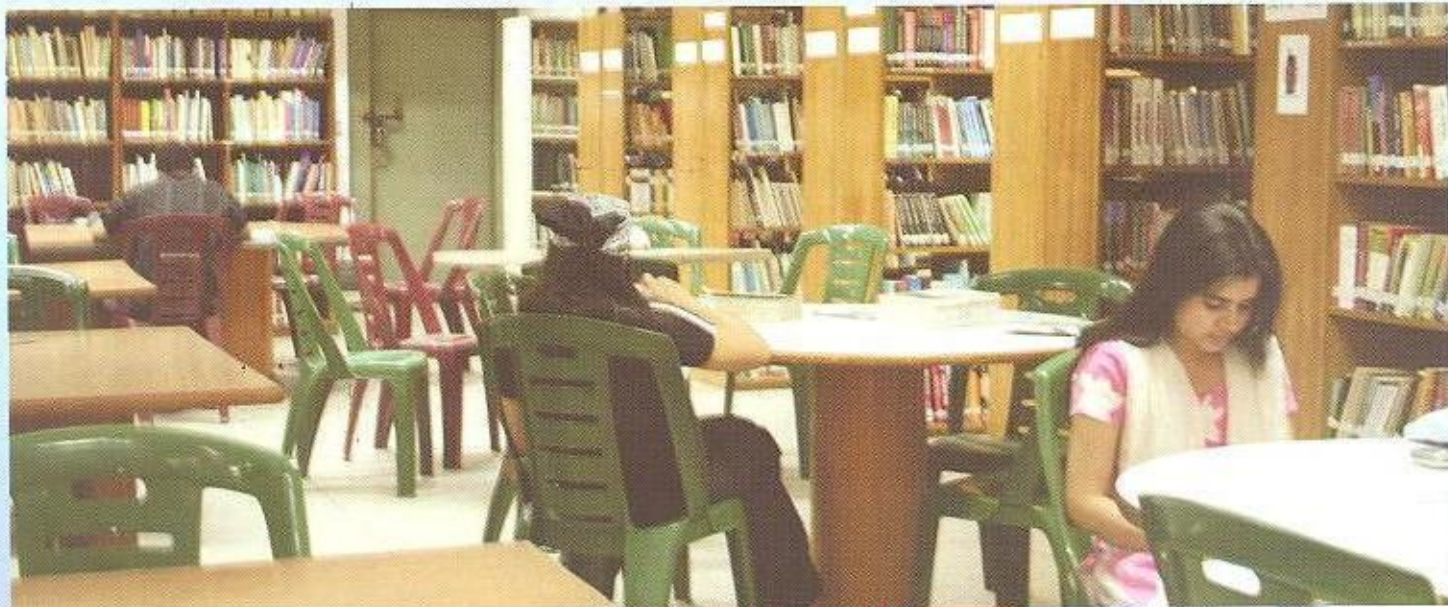

Professional Skills Development Program

A nine week long Professional Skills Development Program was launched in December 2004. The main objective of the Program is to develop the students in areas such as professional conduct, presentation skills, interviewing and resume writing, to help them prepare for a competitive job market.

Student Affairs

Student Affairs at BRACU adds another important element to campus life through its extracurricular activities that develop students' academic leadership and teamwork skills. There are a total of 28 clubs and forums and their success depends on the talents, hard work and determination of the members.





DEPARTMENT *of* Architecture



The Department of Architecture was inaugurated in February 2002 with 15 students and 3 faculty members. The department has produced more than 20 graduates through its 5 year program. It now has 200 students and 16 full time faculty members, most of whom have post graduate qualifications from abroad.

The faculty believes in providing high quality architectural education and through a competitive admission process, restricts its entering class to 20 students. The 10 design studios that are the most important part of the curriculum are taught by at least 2 teachers, thus ensuring an excellent student teacher ratio. The host of courses related to architecture such as painting, sculpture and music appreciation are taught by highly qualified external faculty members who are renowned in their individual fields.

Students are required to complete a semester of practical training in architectural offices and they do so not only in Bangladesh but also in India, Malaysia and Hong Kong. The academic environment at the department is enriched by its many co-curricular activities, amongst which are the Angan lecture series, ArchKids outreach program for children and the student cultural forum, Moitree.

BRAC Business School began its journey in the year 2001 as a department within BRAC University, before becoming a business school in 2006. Within a short period the school has made its mark as a center of excellence in the academic and the business community through a rigorous, discipline-based approach to business education. The goal of the school is to transform the students into confident and effective professionals, who can become leaders as they shape their organizations in an age of rapid discontinuous changes.

The school has three distinct programs namely, BBA, MBA and MBM that cater to the different segments of the market. Though the programs vary in pedagogy, they have one common goal of creating professionals for business

The students go through various processes from class room lectures to interactive case sessions to delving in real life situations as they are placed in organizations for case work and a semester long internship. 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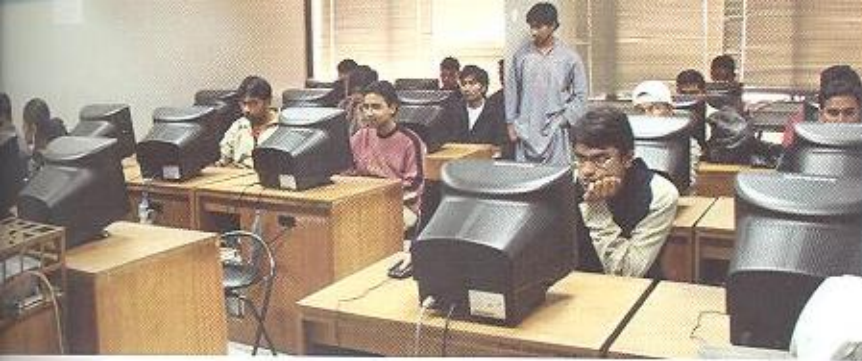

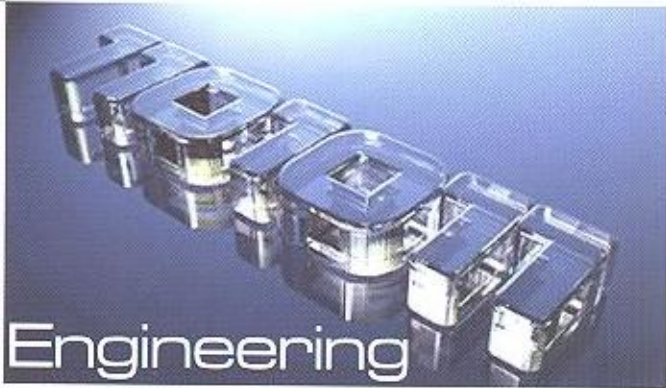

Department *of* Computer Science and Engineering



The department offers undergraduate degrees in Computer Science, Computer Science and Engineering and Electronics and Communication Engineering. It also conducts CISCO Certified Network Associate (CCNA) programs, since the university became an authorized CISCO Networking Academy.

The department's strengths at a glance:

- It boasts a group of faculties with strong academic (both local and foreign) and professional backgrounds in relevant fields.
- Graduates of the department pursue careers in prominent organizations such as GrameenPhone, Banglalink Telecom, Citycell, Warid Telecom, Nokia, Ericsson, BJIT, CellBazar, Southtech, TherapBD, Texas Groups, BRAC Bank, Standard Chartered Bank and Mobil.
- 22% of these graduates have sought higher education in renowned foreign universities of North America, Europe and Australia.
- The department encourages undergraduate students to work on research projects. A good number of projects based on these studies by students and teachers have already been presented at notable international conferences.
- The department successfully organized the 7th International Conference on Computer and Information Technology (ICCIT 2004), Dhaka, Bangladesh, December 2004.
- The department conducts research in different areas with the support and collaboration of the International Development Research Centre, Royal Institute of Technology and Microsoft Corporation.
- The department supported BRAC University Computer Club organizes intra-university programming, gaming and quiz contests. It also represented the university at various contests and won a number of awards.
- Through BUCC, the department organizes training workshops, boot camps and seminars. Some of the notable events are Open Office and Open-source seminar, Localization of Open-source Software (boot camp) and Informational Event on Work and Life at Microsoft USA (jointly offered with the Career Services Office of BRACU).
- Members of BUCC conduct 'course help sessions' for students needing assistance in various courses.

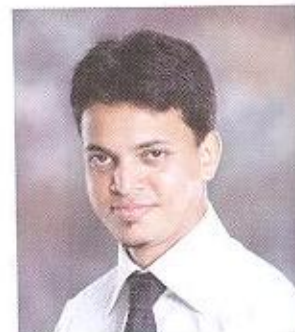

Department of English and Humanities

The Department of English and Humanities offers both a Bachelor and Master of Arts in English. The BA programme consists of three streams: Literature, Linguistics and Language, and Media and Cultural Studies. The literature stream brings students up to date with a wide variety of English writing from different historical periods and regions, encouraging them to explore the relationship of literary works to their historical contexts and to other disciplines. The linguistic and language stream offers a well-balanced curriculum of theory and practice, equipping students equipped with skills for English language teaching. The Media and culture concentration is interdisciplinary in nature, giving students a good foundation in the history of ideas and cultural theory to interpret the ever-changing cultural traditions and to provide insights into their own experience. All students are supposed to write a dissertation in a specialized area or do an internship decided by the department in consultation with the students. While the dissertation makes students better equipped in academic writing and research skills, making the transition to an MA programme easier, the internship offers them hands on training as well as a rare opportunity to bridge the gap between theory and practice before plunging into the job market.

The MA programme consists of two streams: ELT and Applied Linguistic and Literature but students can also take a combination of the two.

The curriculum as a whole puts a special emphasis on writing courses, which develop students' writing skills. To support the department's rigorous academic programme and achieve the level of writing required for the undergraduate dissertation, the department has a writing tutorial centre staffed by faculty and students from the department, in which students can receive individualized peer tutoring for their written work.

Apart from organizing workshops, seminars and talks by eminent scholars and practitioners from various fields, the department fosters creative talents in students by giving them opportunity to share their talents.

With a view to recognize, encourage and endorse effective, transparent, accountable, equitable and citizen-friendly government in Bangladesh and in South Asia, the Institute of Governance Studies (formerly known as Centre for Governance Studies) started its mission in 2006 under the umbrella of BRAC University. Since its inception, the institute has been a pioneer in disseminating quality education and training in the field of governance and development, and offers a post-graduate degree and professional training and undertakes extensive and invaluable research in the concerned fields.

The institute has set itself apart from others in that:

It has a highly capable and experienced group of faculty members, comprised of professors from renowned local institutes and from foreign institutes such as Harvard, Monash, and the National University of Singapore.

As of this date, the institute has housed three Fulbright scholars who have worked on developing capacity for research and teaching curriculum in Bangladesh.

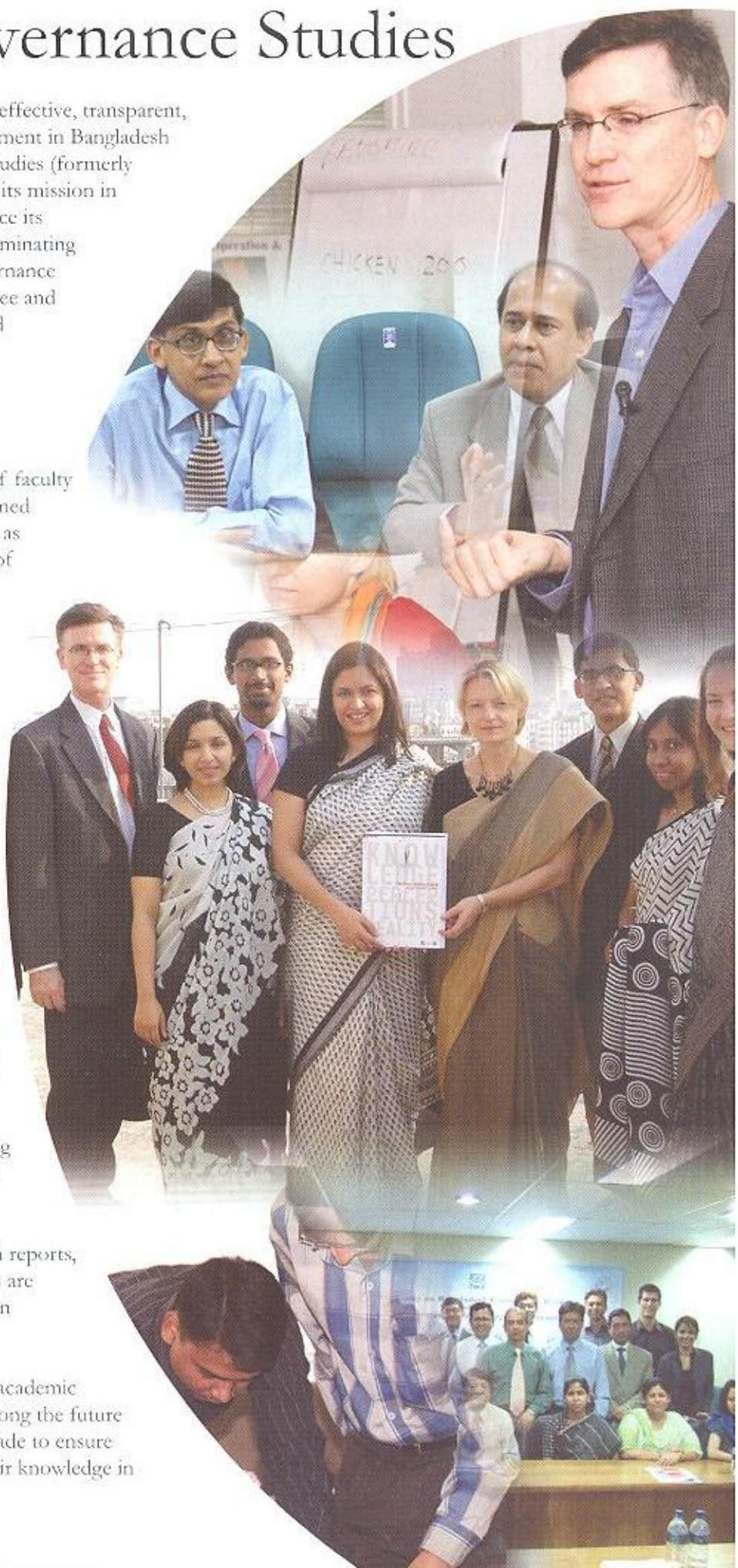
IGS utilizes the expertise of its international instructors by making use of distance learning through video conferencing.

The Masters in Governance and Development (MAGD) program has been fashioned in consultation with the Ash Institute for Democratic Governance and Innovation of the Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University, Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy at the National University of Singapore, Monash University in Australia, and the University of Malay in Malaysia.

IGS promotes participatory methods of learning through case studies, field visits, and interaction with experts and practitioners.

The Annual State of Governance in Bangladesh reports, policy papers, and studies of public institutions are published so as to distribute research findings on governance to the public.

The programs offered by the institute improve academic qualification and build a better constituency among the future leaders of the nation. Huge efforts are being made to ensure that participants think analytically and apply their knowledge in practice.



Department of Economics and Social Sciences



The Economics and Social Sciences (ESS) Department is an integral part of the university and a very resourceful one too. It has about fourteen full-time and four part-time teachers. Among them five hold a PhD degree from various renowned institutions and others have a Masters Degree from both home and abroad in different fields of economics and social science. The department has also managed to create a research team where many of the faculties are doing their research work. ESS inaugurated its Masters Program in Applied Economics this year. Additionally, it has introduced a sociology minor which is closely related to our field of study. The department also has a library of its own where the students can read books of related interests and acquire in depth knowledge.

The ESS department is different from most of the departments in many ways. One of the very unique characteristics of this department is that the teacher-student interaction is very high. This is the result of the excellent teacher to student ratio. For this reason the students always get more attention and care from all the faculties. Additionally, a limited number of students helps ensure a good and healthy peer relationship.

Another characteristic of the department is the enthusiasm of the faculties and students for various club activities. ESS hosts the BRAC University Economics Club (BUEC), Rural Development Club (RDC), Oikos and Art Society, which is mainly maintained and supervised by our faculty members. These clubs have different activities to improve the department, the students and the society. Some mentionable activities by the clubs are as follows: BUEC organized student help group classes; RDC organized different fund raising activities for the 'Bhobodaho' project; Oikos looks into different socio-environmental and economic aspects and activities globally. The Art Society, which is a very unique club of the department, organized different forms of art exhibitions and cultural events.

Altogether the ESS is a well organized department, where the students not only get proper economic knowledge but also apply it in different club affairs. Our department is successful in integrating the in depth knowledge with its practical use.

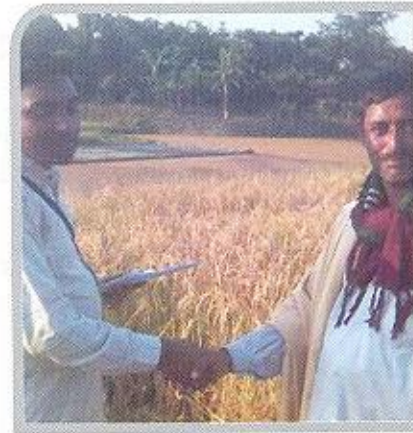
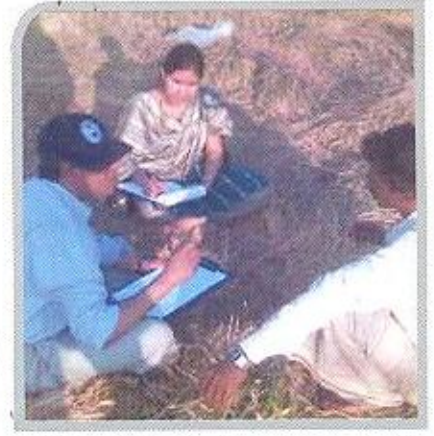
Development Studies Program

- It is immensely advantaged by being part of BRAC, which enables the school to utilize the NGO's health program components, (i) Essential Health Care (ii) Facility based services (iii) Government of Bangladesh and BRAC Partnership Programs and (iv) Pilot programs for research and education purpose.
- A partnership with ICDDR,B facilitates access to state-of-the-art laboratories, libraries and the world's long-running and most sophisticated demographic surveillance system in Matlab and co-operation from top-notch researchers
- Collaboration with schools of public health in the North, Europe and North America (Columbia University, Johns Hopkins University, Harvard University, George Washington University, University of Amsterdam, London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine and so on) assists access to the rich academic resources of these schools and the design of relevant curriculum and at the same time orients the teaching staff towards a more balanced global health agenda.
- Community-Based Experiential Learning: A huge emphasis is given on community-based experiential learning. Students have to spend the first six months in a rural setting, where they can apply hands-on learning techniques during the course of their studies and enhance learning further through team formation. They spend the second semester in Dhaka city, focusing their field activities in urban slum settlements.

- The school boasts need blind admissions for local students and students of low income countries through generous grants from the Rockefeller Foundation, The James P. Grant Trust, The World Bank, UNICEF, and BRAC (Bangladesh and Afghanistan).
- The school is benefited by the endowment of a one million dollar Global Health Award received by BRAC from the Gates Foundation in 2004.

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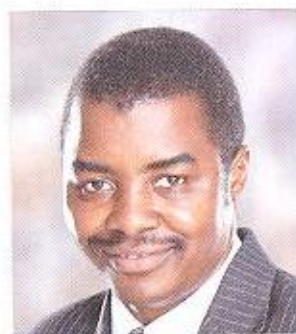
