

Shabana Azmi visits Dhaka



Veteran Indian actress Shabana Azmi, recently visited Dhaka to take part in a private university graduation ceremony. The five times Indian National Film Awards winner joined the 11th Convocation of Brac University, held on December 5, in the capital.

In the graduation ceremony, the legendary actress delivered a speech to the recent graduates. The actress said in her speech that, “One can not measure success by comparing only job and payment. Anyone can have as much money as he/she wants. However, to what extent you are successful in life could only be measured in a way that what citizen you are to the world. A physician can sing, write or paint as well which represents his/her personality. An example of success is how you involve creativity in the world.”

In the ceremony, Azmi recited a poem of her father Kaifi Azmi, an Indian Urdu poet who will always be remembered for bringing Urdu literature to Indian motion pictures.
