Chapter 1

Introduction

From my early childhood, I was very curious about how journalism worked. Whenever the morning paper arrived at our door, I went to pick it up and looking at it wondered who penned all these writings and how did they get all these information. Whenever the news came on the TV, I was always curious about it and sneaked up behind the set trying to find the doorway through which the presenter got in. I grew up and came to understand how it all worked and my curiosity turned into interest.

Now, we live in a virtual environment where everybody is online. We are getting our entertainment online, our business online, study materials online. And just like everything else, the news is also online. Especially after the pandemic, our whole idea of living a normal life has changed. We have become much more dependent on the internet for communication and getting information. This section is one of the main sections of the whole news

portal. To be more specific, this section covers all the daily news that goes online. It engages millions of people by giving updates through *Tribune's* official Facebook page, Instagram page, Twitter, etc. However, social media changed journalism in a lot of ways both good and bad. One of the good sides is the direct connection with the people by reaching a wide number of audiences through digital media. On other hand, the news portals are providing the consumer relevant news based on their preferences, interests, and search results. On the other hand, the consumer has both the power and the responsibility to select and filter certain kinds of news that they want to see on their social media.

My supervisor at the office, Tilka Binte Mehtab handed me the responsibility of sharing and updating news links along with captions on the *Dhaka Tribune's* various social media pages. I had to edit small pieces of news stories both in Bangla and English and had to translate them as well. I also interned as a news presenter where I had to give voice-overs and write my own scripts. Every day was a new challenge for me as I learned numerous new skills and techniques for collecting, processing, and professionally presenting news. The entire experience has helped me prepare myself as a proficient journalist for my upcoming days on this career path.

Chapter 2

A brief history of *Dhaka Tribune*

Dhaka Tribune is a national English newspaper launched in Dhaka, 2013. They have another group named Bangla Tribune where the main highlights are Bangla news. The newspaper always maintains gender equality in their news.

It functions with the motto, “Breaking News, Breaking Barrier” and it has to uphold its market popularity as a well-known newspaper. Media outlets of *Dhaka Tribune* engage lots of people. This newspaper is owned by Gemcon Group. It has been continuing its market position from day one. Mr. Zafar Sobhan is the editor of this renowned newspaper.

It is a reliable source of news and its motive is to serve accurate information on time. This newspaper regularly publishes its weekly features regarding healthcare, sports, etc. It puts contribution on alarming issues e.g., Rape cases, Coronavirus updates, Rohingya issues, Sports, Gender-related issues, etc. *Dhaka Tribune* is the first newspaper where the rapist's face was revealed. This news was published on 13th July 2021 where Chittagong police arrested a man regarding his unsuccessful attempt to rape a schoolgirl. This gives another level of acceptance to society. This newspaper tries to maintain all kinds of creative writing in a very precise way. It attempts to write accurate information persistently.

Also, this newspaper arranges a show named ‘Straight Talk with Zafar Sobhan. This show has been covering one on one conversations with newsmakers and opinion shapers. The editor of the newspaper Mr. Zafar Sobhan is the host of this show. He invites renowned guests in this show e.g. Afsan Chowdhury (journalist, teacher, writer, and historian), Dr. Gowher Rizvi (historian, scholar, and educationist), Mohammad Hanif (writer and journalist), Raba Khan (comedian, and vlogger), Kiswar Chowdhury, (Masterchef Australia’s finalist), etc. Kiswar was the MasterChef Australia finalist of 2021 who presented the Bangladeshi heritage in her dishes, gave her interview to *Dhaka Tribune*.

Similarly, actress Azmeri Haque Badhon shared her remarkable come-back and gave an interview about women’s rights and discrimination to *Dhaka Tribune*.



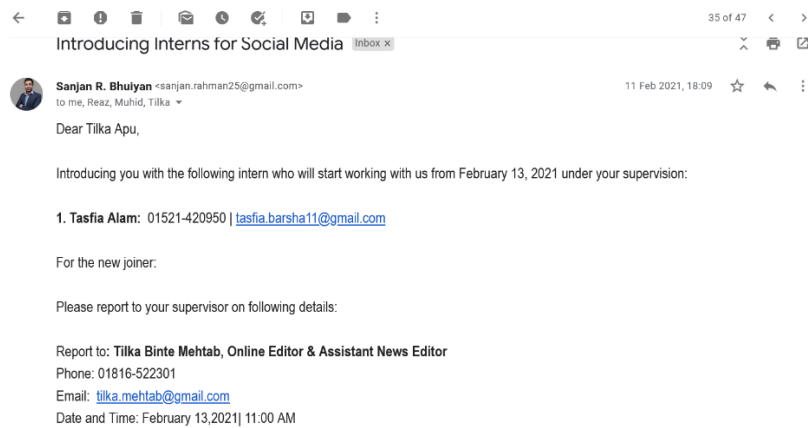
Figure 2: Actress Badhon interviewed

It welcomes young students and puts an enormous amount of effort to prepare them into pursuing their life as a journalist. *Tribune* is a gender-neutral organization in the matter of their working environment. The work environment is safe and flexible for both males and females. Recently, this organization started working on daily news updates named ‘*Dhaka Tribune Bulletin*’ twice a day. It started on the 1st of July, 2021. Every day this newspaper publishes important news bulletin on time where people can get the most important and updated news of the day.

Chapter 3

This media outlet has different sections e.g. central desk, *Bangla Tribune*, social media sector. All departments are also divided into print and online sections. Online sections operate through Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, the official page of the *Dhaka Tribune*, etc. On the other hand, print media sections dominate magazines, sports, etc.

I started my journey as an intern at the social media team in *Dhaka Tribune* on the 13th of February, 2021. Social media can be considered as the largest way of communication medium nowadays. The online section works in a very different way than print media. Online news pressure is huge in terms of publishing news. All the news for the online section is posted in various ways. For example, the front page of the newspaper posted all the social sites every day at 9 am. News is published in an online sector and immediately posted on social sites as all social sites are engaged with the masses.

However, I worked with eight other members of the social media team. All of them were working from home because of the pandemic. My team members were very supportive during

my work. One of my senior team members introduced me to the official rules and regulations along with the procedure and format of the work. I had to work thirty-five hours per week. They advised me to keep an eye on the daily news. They also added me to their social media groups where we all can connect.

Tilka Binte Mehtab, my supervisor guided me throughout my internship as well as the team members. I received a wonderful chance to learn how to work as a journalist in one of the biggest social media outlets in our country. My undergraduate courses helped me a lot to practice my knowledge during my internship. As a student of English and humanities, I am doing major in Media and Cultural studies. I took several courses at BRAC University regarding journalism. Journalism courses are Editing, Copy Writing, Translation Studies, Cultural Studies, Print media, Globalization, and The Media, etc. All the courses help me to understand media representation and journalism in a bookish way. *Dhaka Tribune's* online platform helped me a lot to use my academic knowledge in a professional field. I had no practical idea of how this newspaper organization works before starting my internship. During my online internship, I noticed that academic knowledge and practical experience both are important in terms of pursuing a career as a journalist. It is like an interdependent work where one must have the academic knowledge as well as the capacity to execute that in his or her professional field.

At *Tribune*, I worked as a scriptwriter, news representative, translator, etc. I was also responsible for sharing news on social media platform. Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter were three platforms where we were continuously sharing the updates. I was assigned the responsibility for updating news stories. Usually, we shared the website link on Facebook with a thumbnail. If any news got updated, for example, the photo or the headline or the caption of the news had to be changed, then we had to refresh that news so that the updated thumbnail showed on the main page. I had the responsibility to do this job very carefully and on time. It

is very important to maintain the time to grab several audiences immediately. In online journalism, maintaining social media platforms are like a roller coaster ride. It is a focused job where mistakes are mostly not allowed. Any wrong information can create a negative impact on the organization. On social media, every news story gets viral in a minute. As a result, I had to recheck every news story before sharing it.

Chapter 4

Translation works and writings

As an intern, I used to translate text and captions for infographics. I translated captions from English to Bangla. Texts I translated like the national Flag Day, Kazi Nazrul Islam's 122nd birthday, Nirapod Matritto Dibosh. I had to translate small write-ups during my internship. The course "Translation Studies" helped me a lot regarding the techniques of translation.

Every day I was advised to share news on different platforms along with other work. As an intern, I had to translate texts for infographics. Translation Studies (ENG 465) was a course where I learned different ways of translation by not changing their real meaning. As a translator, one must have ideas of the basic rules of translation e.g. translation shift, target audience, sense for sense translation, translation loss and compromise, etc. When I translated texts for the newspaper, I applied my academic knowledge from this translation course. These techniques are helpful because I can relate my work and book knowledge together. A good translator should follow the proper rules of translation.

I wrote news scripts for news presentations both in English and Bangla. In this case, I had to translate some English news into Bangla. Therefore, 'sense for sense' was applied for this case. News bulletins contain the most focused issues for every day. I had to identify the urgent issues and write them precisely to make a presentable bulletin script. I wrote scripts for the bulletin almost every day for the news bulletin. For COVID news, I had to collect all the authentic information about the death toll, affected history, world records, vaccine updates, recovery updates, etc. The main focus of the writing was to connect the audience with the essence of the news. My assignment was to write bulletin scripts and make a voice recording on them. I was

the news presenter along with another teammate in my social media team. We both used to submit our scripts and regular voice recording to our supervisor. We were in a trial period for almost one month.

Chapter 5

Social Media management

The main aspect of my work at *Dhaka Tribune* was to handle social media and its contents. I was responsible for sharing news on social sites, update captions, write photo captions for infographic articles, etc. Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter were three platforms where I was responsible for sharing news and stories.

During the first month of my internship, my task was to DNR the news of Facebook. DNR denotes the term Debug and Refresh. I had to share a website like on Facebook with a caption. Whenever news needs to be updated, the previously shared news story needs to refresh. That time, I had to DNR news so that the older version changed into a newer update. For example, if I had to publish the total number of the COVID-19 death toll in our country for a day, I had to wait for the exact news. Sometimes, I received the story and immediately published that on our page. Later, the number of death counts had increased. In that case, I had to “DNR”, the older news for the new update. There were rules and regulations that I had to follow while posting anything on social media. Every day at 9:00 am, I had to post the front page of the news.

My supervisor asked me to alert myself about other news platforms, such as BBC News, CNN, local news channels, Channel I, Channel 24, The Daily Star, etc. She also advised me to notice which kinds of news get more views and shares. Her instruction helped me to identify which is more relevant to share.

On Twitter, I had to share national news, news that had international importance, sports news tagging the official pages of the athletes, etc. For example, if I shared News of Tamim Iqbal, I had to mention or tag that on his official Twitter handle. Along with that, I had to share stories on Instagram. On Instagram, I used photo captions for the stories, the weblinks and posted them

on Tribune's official page. Also, I managed push notifications on the official page of the *Dhaka Tribune*. Push notifications are significant for increasing views on social media platforms. It speeds on various platforms to grab the attention of the mass. Moreover, the most important features of social media management are interactivity. It allows people to like, share, read, and comment on any stories or articles.

Chapter 6

News Bulletins

In the last month of my internship, my task was to write news scripts for the news bulletin and making voice-overs. I had to choose informative national news for making the script. The first news I had to cover was COVID news. I collected updates of the pandemic then organized them to make a bulletin script.

After making professional scripts and presenting news bulletins, I finally realized my beat in-stream journalism. Delivering a voice-over for the first time was an experience I will never forget in my life. I followed the professional format of the presentation. At the time of the pandemic, I had to present the news with an update on coronavirus. The topics I covered for the bulletins were Breaking News, COVID News, National News, International, Sports or Features, etc.

When it came to Bangla news, I had to use different translation theories. The script of Bangla news targeted the mass population. Hence, the language of Bangla news had to be more direct and easily conceivable. Scripting in Bangla required an entirely different set of skills in terms of vocabulary and narrative from scripting in English. However, scripting in English was comparatively easy for me. Therefore, I had to maintain a professional tone while simply abiding by the rules of grammar. Writing a script is pretty much like writing a story. The difference is the story in the bulletin is true.

In those days, I had to use my voice as a news presenter. Scripting a story and delivering it as a voice-over are more different from each other. In the voice-over, one needs to sound calm and reserved. It was an entirely new experience for me as I never did anything like this before. I also got the freedom to make the script according to my style of narrative. After making the scripts, my responsibility was to make voice-overs of news bulletins. In the last two weeks of

my internship, I continuously made scripts and prepare voice-overs for the news bulletins as a demo. I had to cover the most highlighted stories for news bulletins.

Therefore, the experience of a news presenter made me realize that I can deliver any news patiently. I learned many more small details in the internship. First of all, at the beginning of the bulletin, I had to introduce my name, the time. I practiced many times in a day to create a professional tone in my voice. I realized that news presentation is a tough job as it requires patience. In the first days of practicing, I used to mumble words when I became nervous. I also learned that find out relevant topics for the bulletin is the main focus of presenting news. Besides, short and simple scripts can help to make a good presentation. Bulletin news needs to be specific and focused. All the experiences of the news bulletin encourage me to pursue my career as a news presenter in the future.

Chapter 7

Internship Experience

I have started my internship in February 2021 during the COVID-19-19 pandemic. I was so excited about going to the office and experience the first internship of my life. However, physical communication was not possible for the pandemic. Therefore, I had to work from home. I officially started my journey on 13th February 2021. My first experience in the professional world is one of the best experiences of my life. I have learned so many things from my seniors and my supervisor Tilka Binte Mehtab. The online environment and work ethics of my teammates were outstanding.

I gathered remarkable memories while working for *Dhaka Tribune*. Initially, I was confused and scared about the online office because the pandemic had made a noticeable impact on almost every aspect of our personal, academic, and professional lives. Later, all kinds of support from my team members and working environment helped me to identify my potential. The support I received from the team members encouraged me a lot to work better day by day. I felt that the working environment and the support of team members can motivate a person in a different way. In this new platform, the smallest task is equally important as the biggest. I used to be afraid of communicating as I was new at that place, but I had to communicate with my co-workers every day. This communication made me more involved and serious about my job.

Besides, working on the news representation of COVID-19 made me humble and enthusiastic. I had to work on COVID-19 updates and create audio recordings on the COVID-19 bulletin every day. News presentation was my dream job. Fortunately, I received that golden opportunity at my workplace. I had to prepare writings and recordings for the news bulletin within a specific time limit. My supervisor allocated time to finish my bulletin task, I finally

learned to maintain deadlines. I realized that I completed my assignments well whenever I was assigned to present news for the bulletin.

In addition, it was a huge responsibility for me to cover the stories for news bulletins. It was a trial bulletin practice that was not aired back then. But, I still count this as one of my most memorable experiences. Without the support of my supervisor, it would have been difficult for me to be a presenter for the news bulletin. She corrected me a lot and saw the best version of me that I could not notice myself. Also, infographic articles that I wrote were published frequently. I felt happy and accomplished seeing them published.

Moreover, I learned time management and professionalism in my workplace. In the social media sector, time management is crucial because social platforms are always interactive and ever-changing. I was working under shifts where my time started from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. The workload depended on the urgency of the news stories. For example, there seems to be a rise in the regular flow of news stories on special occasions, such as national holidays or religious festivals. Sometimes, I felt tensed and worried about the load of work but I always managed to submit my tasks on time.

Chapter 8

Theory Application in My Internship Assignments

Throughout my three months of internship at *Dhaka Tribune*, I understood how my academic theories are relatable to the job I was doing. Some content I applied for this section are from the courses: English for the Print Media (ENG440), Cultural studies (ENG331), Copywriting (ENG404), Globalization, and The Media (ENG333).

News is collective information published in newspapers, journals, magazines and broadcast on TV, radio, online platforms about current events. There are five news value factors in journalism. The factors are timeliness, prominence, proximity, consequence, and oddity. News value factors determine which events or incidences are newsworthy in terms of publication. In this report, I will talk about timeliness and prominence.

Timeliness:

Timeliness is one of the news value factors of journalism. It refers to a piece of current news that needs to publish at the exact time. Timeliness talks about recent stories just after the event takes place. For example, if any particular topic gets highlighted then, news portals should cover that topic immediately. At the time of my internship, I had to publish COVID-19 updates just after I received them. As a social media intern, my task was to publish important and relevant news as soon as possible during my working hours. The motif of social media is getting more views in less time. An ideal news portal should try to catch up with its ever-flowing nature and deliver the most relevant and reliable news at the quickest pace.

My supervisor strictly instructed me to post the COVID-19 news immediately, using the hashtag #BREAKING>>>>. Also, I had to tweet national and international sports news on

Twitter and was assigned to tag sports personalities. Timeliness is a crucial factor in the case of media sectors. Since my internship consisted entirely of working from home, I tried to maintain timeliness during my shifts.

Prominence:

News value is a crucial part of social media journalism. It is the criteria that determine the importance or significance of news holds in order to be shared on a social platform. For example, the news of Kishwar Chowdhury became viral, who is one of the finalists of MasterChef Australia season 13. This news became glorified all over the world. People loved to watch her simple presentation of Bangladeshi cuisine this season. *Dhaka Tribune* covered the news many times, and the editor of this outlet interviewed her. This news carries prominence all over the world.

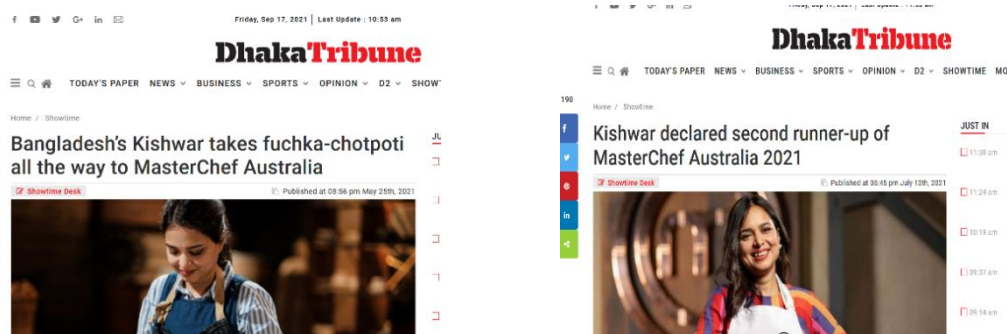


Figure 5: Finalist of MasterChef Australia 13

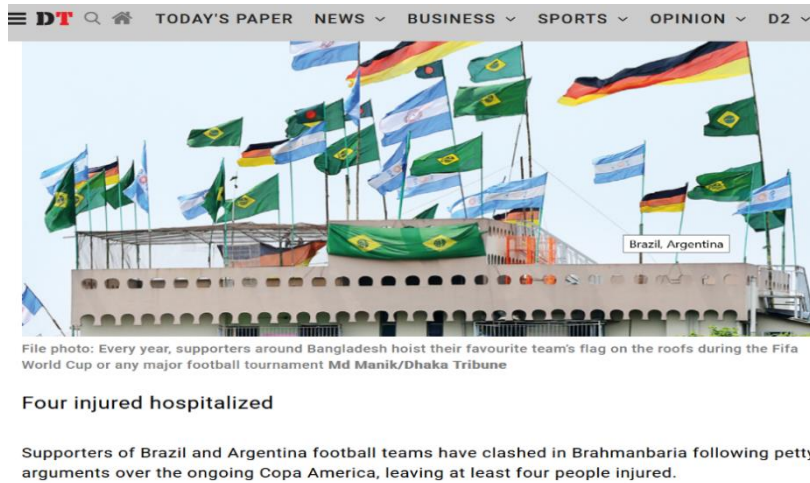


Figure 6: Fight between supporters of two teams

আজ বাংলাদেশের জাতীয় পতাকা দিবস, আজ সেইদিন, যেদিন কিনা এই স্বাধীন বাংলাদেশের পতাকা প্রথমবারের মত পূর্ব পাকিস্তানের মাটিতে উত্তোলন করা হয়েছিল। এই দিনটি আনুষ্ঠানিকভাবে স্বীকৃতি পেয়েছিল ১৯৭১ সালের ১৭ জানুয়ারি।

পতাকাটি প্রথম ঢাকা বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের কলাভবনের সামনে সেই সময়ের ঢাকাসুর সহ-সভাপতি আ স ম আব্দুর রব উত্তোলন করেছিলেন। সবুজের মাঝে লাল রঙের বৃত্তাকার পতাকাটি স্বাধীন বাংলার প্রতীক হিসেবে বিবেচনা করা হয়। পতাকার সবুজ অংশটি বাংলার সবুজ সৌন্দর্য এবং তরুণদের সাহসিকতার পরিচয় দেয়। লাল অংশটি মুক্তিযুদ্ধের বাংলার মানুষের আত্মত্যাগের বর্ণনা করে। প্রথম পতাকাটি ডিজাইন করা সিরাজুল আলম নামে এক শিক্ষার্থীর, যেটি পূর্ব পাকিস্তানের সেনার সেলুলয়েডের মানচিত্রে একটি লাল ডিস্ক নিয়েছিল। একান্তরের মাঠে যখন বঙ্গবন্ধু শেখ মুজিবুর রহমান স্বাধীন বাংলাদেশের কথা বলেছিলেন তখন তাকে পতাকাটি দেখানো হয়েছিল।

পরবর্তীতে, ১৩ জানুয়ারি, ১৯৭২ সালে এ পতাকাটির নকশায় কিছু সংশোধন ও পরিবর্তন আনা হয়। পতাকার মাঝ থেকে মানচিত্রের নকশাটি অপসারণ করা হয় এবং লাল চক্রাকার অংশটি সরিয়ে পতাকা বাঁধার খুঁটির আরও কাছে নিয়ে আসা হয়।

জাতীয় পতাকাটি বাংলাদেশের প্রায় সকল গুরুত্বপূর্ণ সরকারি প্রতিষ্ঠানে উত্তোলন করা হয় এবং ২১ ফেব্রুয়ারি অথবা ১৫ আগস্টের মত জাতীয় দিবসগুলোতে এটি অর্ধনমিত অবস্থায় থাকে।

যেকোনো দেশপ্রেমিক মানুষের জন্য জাতীয় পতাকা অসাধারণ গুরুত্ব বহন করে কেননা জাতীয় পতাকা যেকোনো দেশের স্বাধীনতা ও সার্বভৌমত্বের পরিচয় দেয়। আমাদের জাতীয় পতাকার প্রতি সম্মান করা আমাদের দায়িত্ব এবং আমরা যদি এই পতাকার প্রতি কোনো অসম্মানজনক কিছু করতে দেখি তাহলে অবশ্যই আমাদের জাতীয় পতাকার মর্যাদা রক্ষায় এগিয়ে আসতে হবে।

As the number of COVID-19 cases rise to an all-time high, Bangladesh is faced with the challenge of keeping the economy afloat without endangering the health of the masses. Under the strict lockdown for the next few days, starting from the fourteenth of April, all government, semi-government, and autonomous institutions have been ordered to cease operation on premises. International and domestic flights along with bus and train ser-

Mia Avenue to deliver people to their workplaces. Despite these dire situations, civilians are regularly caught violating lockdown with excuses ranging from phony emergencies to vaccinations.

Meanwhile, hospitals are running out of ICU beds to provide for COVID-19 patients and doctors are facing inhumane work hours to meet with the overwhelming number of patients, which is aggravated by patients with mild and medium symptoms who crowding at hospitals instead of staying home. Also, because of the lockdown, lack of transportation is further hindering people from seeking emergency medical care. To fight the second wave of COVID-19 pandemic, Salma Adil Foundation (SAF) in collaboration with Chittagong Medical College Teachers Association (CMCTA) has created a dedicated COVID-19 testing booth for the frontline doctors and a very limited number of general people. The volunteers of SAF also deliver PPEs and provide free tests to people with the symptom of COVID-19 positive in both Dhaka and Chittagong. Experts also fear other health risks to children who are forced to attend school online, receiving unhealthy

vices will also be halted for the next few days. However, authority has allowed factories and banks to remain open as long as they make their own arrangements for transporting employees. Stores that are supplying food, essentials and medical services will also remain open during the lockdown. The country of over a hundred and sixty million has recorded over ten thousand deaths so far due to this pandemic with a thousand and thirty-five in April alone.
