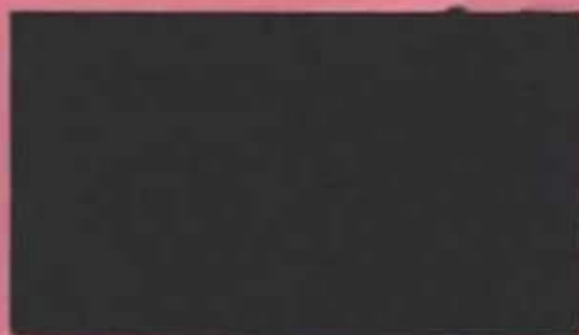

Notes : g/ Each household is now eligible to have only one member in the VO. Subsequently the households which had more than 1 member in the VO have been asked to reduce their membership into one. In addition to that emphasis placed on better disciplines from 1993 and strong scrutiny of existing members led to a reduction in membership. These factors together led to suspension of 78,725 members in 1993. As a result a number of VOs either was disintegrated or were merged into other VOs. This affected a total of 1,203 VOs. The expelled members had a total of Tk. 78.47 million savings which has been refunded to them. This includes Tk. 69.69 million refunded from the 'Own Savings Account'.

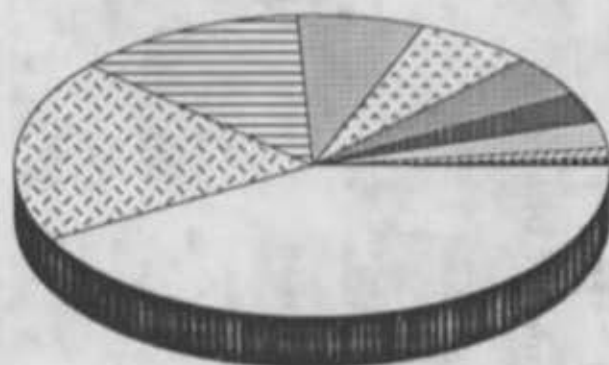

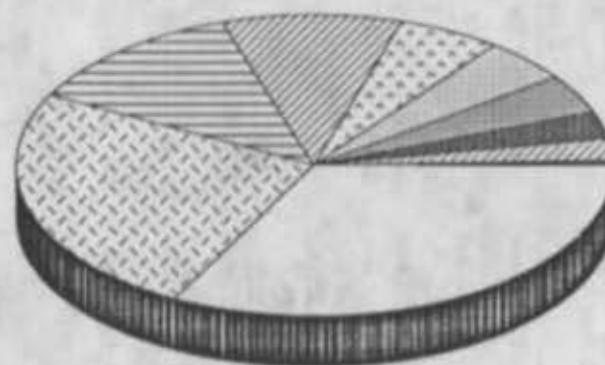
