

# Dev projects should be implemented considering climate impacts: experts

Water resource and climate change expert Ainun Nishat on Saturday said that the government should undertake development projects considering the climate change impacts.

‘We should think twice before taking any development project as traditional development activities pose serious threat to the environment,’ he said while addressing a workshop titled Investigating Climate Change and Environmental Research.

Centre for Climate Change and Environmental Research of BRAC University and Journalist Network of Bengal Delta organised the workshop for journalists.

Ainun Nishat urged journalists to be prepared to track down implementation of projects run by fund disbursed with the aim to mitigate climate change impacts.

He said that many projects taken by Bangladesh government to deal with climate change impacts were faulty in design.
