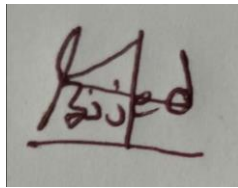

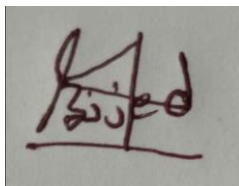

Executive Summary

Outsourcing industry in Bangladesh is flourishing day by day. According to the Oxford Internet Institute (OII), about 5,00,000 active freelancers are working regularly in Bangladesh, out of 6,50,000 registered freelancers. Bangladesh supplies 16% of the total online workers worldwide, the second highest after India. Currently, Bangladesh has 103.253 million internet users. In the last few years, BPO (Businesses process outsourcing) sector has gone through massive expansion and it has achieved 24 percent year growth and it shows signs of more expansion. This rapid growth has inspired me to write my internship report on prospects of outsourcing business in Bangladesh.

This is the internship report based on my full-time job at ServiceEngine Ltd as an Analyst under Risk and Compliance division from 18th October, 2016 to till date as a requirement of my MBA program at BRAC Business School, BRAC University. My job experience in outsourcing industry has given me the opportunity to explore this sector.

In the first part of the report, I have described my company contributions, the benefits I have earned, the challenges I have faced and my suggestions. ServiceEngine Ltd is a leading IT enabled outsourcing firm in Bangladesh. This job has given me the opportunity to explore the outsourcing industry and find its prospects. Outsourcing projects are very unique and the number of projects is infinite. I analyze financial risk data like fraud, corruption, bribery, money laundering etc. There is a separate data capture team that captures crime type, criminal's personal details from authentic daily newspapers published worldwide. Thus, we develop our huge crime database. Our clients are global and they send us their queries and we analyze our database to send them possible risk alerts from our database. It has demand in financial security sector.

In the second part of the report, I included general details and description of the company, management and marketing strategies, technology procedures, challenges and suggestions.

ServiceEngine Ltd is the largest outsourcing firm in Bangladesh in terms of revenue and number of employees. It has joint venture with Abdul Monem Ltd, country's one of the largest conglomerates.

The final part is about the outsourcing industry in Bangladesh. I have analyzed the contribution of this industry in our economy and golden opportunities for this sector to solve the problem of unemployment. I have also discussed about the challenges and my findings, recommendations regarding that. Freelancers of Bangladesh are generating \$100 million annually, according to the ICT Division of Bangladesh. The wage rate in Bangladesh in IT industry is over 50% cheaper than other countries. Labor cost is around \$8 per hour than other BPO countries like Philippines (\$20) and India (\$15). Office set up and infrastructure development costs are also cheap in Bangladesh. Power crisis, low internet speed, money transaction problem, political crisis, lack of technical skills, poor English language knowledge, lack of intellectual property rights are the main problems for the growth of outsourcing industry in Bangladesh. If Government can take immediate actions to solve these issues, thousands of job opportunities can be created in outsourcing industry. More training institutes can help to improve skills. Outsourcing can provide more employment opportunities than many other sectors.

Data analysis is a brainstorming task. Since I work in Risk and Compliance department, there are compliance issues. Our company does not allow me to disclose everything about this job. That is one of the limitations for this report.

Our clients' satisfaction is our main goal. We believe that our business partner's growth will bring growth in our business as well. We have to maintain challenging target of production and quality. Outsourcing business is a global business and there are competitors worldwide. To compete strongly in the market and keep earning remittance are big challenges for us.

We work as a team. Individual interests are given less priority. To meet the Service Level Agreement (SLA), we work all together and thus we have been able to deliver satisfactory service. I have learned how to work as a team and how to co-operate in a professional environment. We help each other if anyone faces difficulties. Without good team work it is not possible to compete in the market.

I have day to day tasks and our team leaders monitor my performance in a regular basis. I have to report to them and environment is very friendly. Our project managers evaluate our whole team performance and they report to the top management.

1.3 Job outcomes

1.3.1 My contribution to the company

I have been working at ServEngine Ltd since last four years. From the very beginning I tried my best to add value in the company. Besides my regular office hours, I contributed in revenue generation by doing overtime. After gaining the initial experience I started to assist the juniors and newcomers. We have 24/7 operations in three shifts morning, evening and night. I have always followed my manager's instructions and there was not a single complaint against me in this period. Since the operation is 24/7, we have night shifts also. Every male employee has to do minimum one night shift in a week. The compliance issue is very strict. In our project we cannot bring mobile phone, camera or any electronic device with us inside the production floor. We have to keep mobile phone in

the locker room. The only way of communication during office hours is office land phone but anyone can use personal mobile by going outside the production floor. So, there can be communication gap with friends and family members. We cannot use any social media like Facebook, YouTube during our office hours.

1.3.4 Suggestions

Maximum difficulties are because of our clients' requirements. Since the project is under Risk and Compliance department, there are many restrictions. The company can minimize Production and quality target to a certain level so that employees can work in a relaxed mood. Failure to meet job target leads to termination. Management should consider more to give employees more opportunities to recover and improve.

More training facilities can be provided so that the trainees learn quickly and get ready for production. The company needs a good number of employee year long. They can have contract with the universities to get quality graduates besides just posting in the online portals.

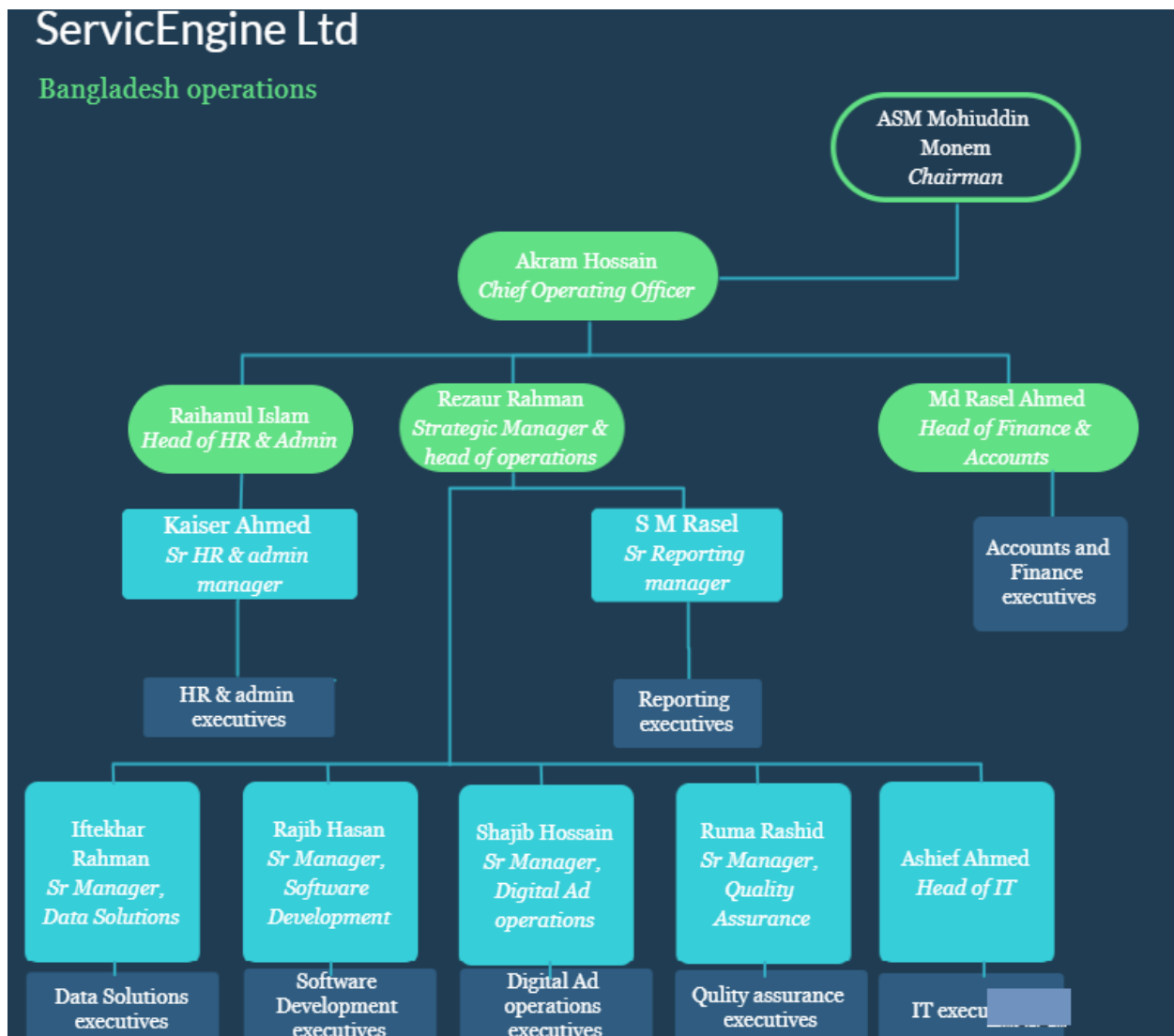

ServicEngine Ltd started its operations in Bangladesh in 2006 with only about 50 employees.

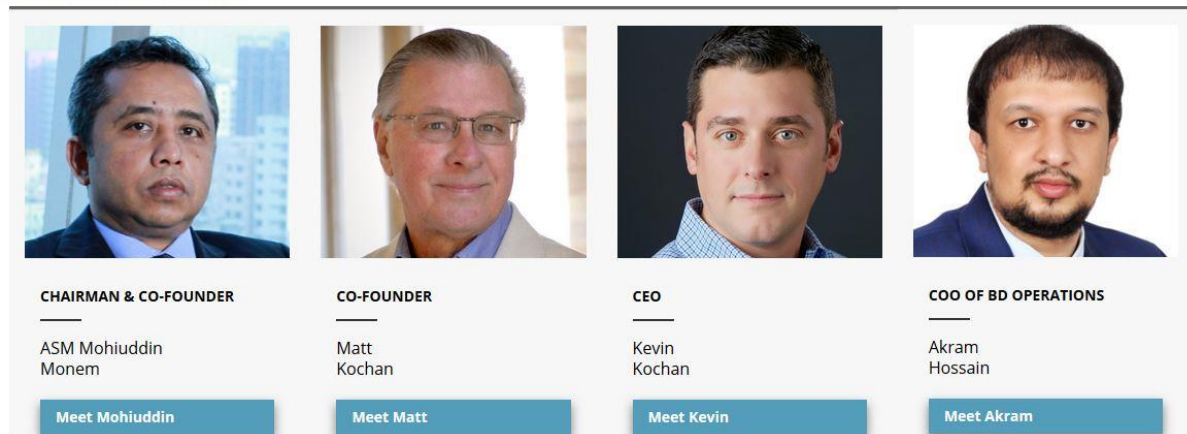
Now, in 2021, about 1,000 employees work full-time here in Bangladesh. This rapid growth indicates the prospects of outsourcing business in Bangladesh.

2.3 Operations Management

Most of the employees are working as Executives/Analyst. Some of them are in mid-level managerial positions like Team Leader, Assistant Manager, Manager, Senior Manager. Every team leader has about 15 executives in his team. Team Leaders are responsible for team performance and work under Assistant Managers' directions. Managers/Assistant Managers have to report to Senior Managers and finally Senior Managers report to the top management about operations and performance.

With Local Area Network (LAN) system all work stations are connected with local server. Local server is also connected with the partner company's server which is located in the USA. For employee performance monitoring and evaluation, we have our own software management system. We use our own official mailing system.

2.5 Competitive Analysis

Strength: ServicEngine is one of the most fastest growing outsourcing companies worldwide. Bangladesh is a very popular destination for outsourcing because of cheap man power. In outsourcing business, it is not necessary to be present physically with clients. It is a joint venture with Abdul Monem Limited, which is one the largest industrial conglomerates in the country. So, the management team as well as the investors are very strong financially. Government is offering many subsidies for outsourcing business. About 1,000 employees are working in ServicEngine and most of them are young aged.

Weaknesses: We lack of highly expert IT workers in Bangladesh. Projects like software development needs skilled employees but we do not have that much skilled candidates though there is demand. Abdul Monem is a large conglomerate in the country. So they cannot give much attention in this outsourcing business.

Opportunities: Outsourcing industry is developing day by day. It is expected that GDP contribution of this industry can compete with the ready-made garments industry as well. There are lots of outsourcing projects and future prospects. We currently have 8-10 projects but there are many clients worldwide whom we can look forward to. Right now, all clients are from foreign countries. In near future domestic market will also be added in the project list.

Threats: Outsourcing is an open industry. Competitors are worldwide. We have to compete with India, Vietnam, China, Sri Lanka, Pakistan and many other countries. There are many projects and clients who can cancel order any time. IT outsourcing is totally dependent on internet connectivity. So, slow connectivity is a hinder in revenue generation. Political stability is also essential since it is foreign investment.

2.6 Summary and Conclusions:

ServicEngine has taken place in the 1st position in the President's award in IT industry for three consecutive years. Our chairman sir is one of the highest tax payers in the country and has been awarded as a Commercially Important Person (CIP) because of ServicEngine Ltd. It has given employment to thousands of employees. There are lots of prospects for ServicEngine. Though there are domestic and global challenges, we believe with clients' satisfaction, ServicEngine will go so far in near future and will set an example in Bangladesh IT outsourcing industry.

Chapter 3

Prospects of outsourcing Business in Bangladesh

3.1 Introduction:

This report aims to focus on the current situation and future prospects of outsourcing business in Bangladesh. Outsourcing (also sometimes referred to as "contracting out") is a business practice used by companies to reduce costs or improve efficiency by shifting tasks, operations, jobs or processes to an external contracted third party for a significant period of time. The functions that are contracted out can be performed by the third party either onsite or offsite of the business. Outsourcing can be both domestic and foreign contracting. Sometimes it is offshoring or near-shoring. But the business firms usually prefer to contract with the distant countries employee because it reduces their certain cost. In this era of globalization, the global market becomes closer. Here are some common reasons to outsource:

- ✓ Reduce and control operating costs
- ✓ Improve host company focus
- ✓ Gain access to world-class capabilities
- ✓ Free internal resources for other purposes
- ✓ A function is time-consuming to manage or is out of control
- ✓ Insufficient resources are available internally
- ✓ Share risks with a partner company

The basic objectives of the study are:

- 🚦 To know about Business Process Outsourcing sector in Bangladesh.
- 🚦 To know the factors and challenges of outsourcing services in Bangladesh.
- 🚦 To know about the financial benefits of this sectors.
- 🚦 To know about the Government intervention, facilities provided to this sector.
- 🚦 To know the problems and prospects of outsourcing sector in Bangladesh.

3.2 Literature Review:

Most of the times companies outsource their tasks to cut their costs. For instance, they give away their peripheral or "non-core" commercial expenditures, huge burden of tax, high energy charges, disproportionate government regulation and production which also includes labor expenses. The reason for such initiatives is taken to evade unusually high corporate taxes and mandated benefits.

There are 4 types of outsourcing. The types are discussed below:

- ✓ Near-shore Outsourcing
- ✓ Onshore Outsourcing
- ✓ Offshore Outsourcing
- ✓ Business Process Outsourcing (BPO)

Near-shore Outsourcing: The practice of getting the work done by the neighboring countries is known as Near-shore Outsourcing. Corporations usually do this to lessen their costs. For example, America sometimes outsources their work to their neighboring countries like, Mexico and Canada. Japan does the same thing with China.

Onshore Outsourcing: When the subcontractor is from the same geographical boundary, then it is called Onshore Outsourcing. For example, Grameen Phone appointed a 3rd party contractor to collect their unpaid postpaid bills.

Offshore Outsourcing: In this case, the main company outsources their tasks to other countries, which cannot be their neighboring country. For example, in ServisEngine Limited, we have clients from foreign continents. Most of the time Offshore Outsourcing takes place for Information Technology (IT) related works.

Business Process Outsourcing (BPO): Business process outsourcing (BPO) is the contracting of a definite commercial job, such as payroll, human resources (HR) or accounting, to a third-party service benefactor. Usually, BPO is applied as a cost-saving measure for tasks that a corporation or organization needs but does not depend upon to keep their position in the marketplace.

In this paper I have covered the roll of our company in Business process outsourcing (BPO).

3.3 Methodology:

This study is based on theoretical data as well as some statistical data. Regarding my organization information, I have collected all the data from the superior of the organization as well as websites of the ServicingEngine Ltd. Here I tried to show the overall Business Process Outsourcing summary in Bangladesh with a sampling on ServicingEngine Ltd. Data has been sourced and collected, to achieve the objective of the research. They were to be characterized, examined, construed and presented in an orderly manner so that the major points can be found out. All the materials have been gathered from primary and auxiliary sources. Most of the related data has been collected by working in the department and by discussing with the employees and managers. 3.4 Findings and Analysis:

3.4.1 Bangladesh: The Ultimate Destination for Outsourcing

Outsourcing is an easy way to earn money sitting at home, and it is the open source of employment. As we do not have so much job opportunity, we can take outsourcing as a profession even after completing our graduation. It doesn't mean that only younger are eligible for outsourcing, people of all ages from young to old can take outsourcing as an occupation.

One must know the essential thing about outsourcing before the starting of it. Basic computer knowledge, an internet connection, and web browsing experience are the primary requirements for outsourcing. Only these are not enough for starting outsourcing; there is some other essential information that one must know. To know these information, one can take the help of different training center. There are many outsourcing training centers in Bangladesh and anyone can get training from there.



Different outsourcing companies like *upwork.com*, *freelancer.com*, *fiverr.com*, *peopleperhour.com* are offering many jobs and before starting applying for jobs, one should know about the jobs. From online training center, one can learn web designing, web developing, Search Engine Optimization (SEO) and different types of works which are very demand-able jobs in outsourcing companies. These training can help people to take outsourcing as a profession and earn more money. The trainers in advance Information Technology centers can provide you suggestions to get more upwork (job finding site) jobs.

Bangladeshi people are introduced to outsourcing or freelancing in the 21st century. And it gets much popularity within a short period of time. And now people of all ages, male and female are paying much interest in it. Because in this sector, people are getting more success than any

other jobs in our country. Foreign business companies are getting their work completed from us at a low cost which is greater than any other local jobs salary in our country.

3.4.2 Role of the Government

Bangladesh is a developing country as we know and the main hindrance of the way to be a developed country is poverty. The government fails to provide jobs for all educated people. So, the government is emphasizing much on outsourcing because it ensures job opportunity for educated people and young generation. As it is a great scope for getting a suitable job and also beneficial for the national economy, the government has already taken many steps to introduce outsourcing to youth. To train up the people to become a freelancer, the government created many training institutes around the country. But the number of freelancers is greater in cities people than the rural people of Bangladesh. So, the government created many training centers in the urban areas.

On 25th January 2014, the Executive Committee of the National Economic Council (ECNEC) has approved 180 core BDT on outsourcing training in Bangladesh. The training project is known as ‘Learning and Earning Program.’ This project was to create employment opportunity for the young unemployed educated people at the Upazila and union levels. Under Government’s first phase ‘Learning and Earning Program’, 15,000 freelancers have already been developed.

To create 55,000 freelancers at the root-level, the Government has taken steps to launch second phase ‘Learning and Earning Program’ at upazillas. The government is working to turn the 456 Union information Service Centers (UISCs) of the country as a mini freelancing center. Freelancers to be developed under ‘Learning and Earning program’ will get the chance for working in the UISCs. Government plans to develop entrepreneurs from the freelancers.

It creates huge employment opportunities and skilled human resources. Hi-Tech park is full of opportunities to invest in Hi-Tech industry and promote business which are knowledge and capital-based. Information technology, Software Technology, Bio-Technology, Renewable Energy, Green Technology, IT Hardware, IT Enabled Services and R&D etc. are major areas of investment in Hi-Tech industry in Bangladesh.

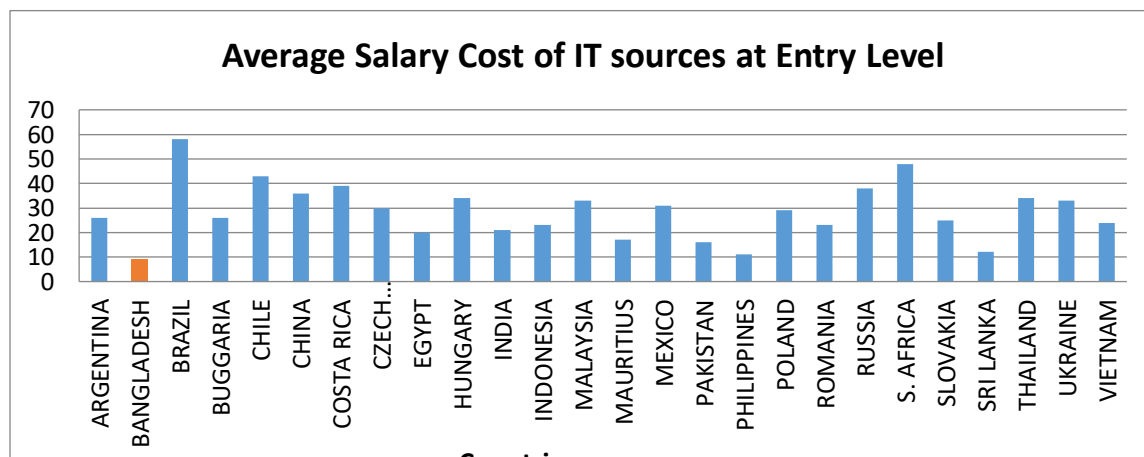
3.4.7 Factors That Make Bangladesh a Favorable BPO Destination

In Bangladesh, there are lots of opportunities like cheap labor, a business hub, sub marine cable advantage, huge resources etc. make lots of opportunities in Bangladesh. For that, there we see a trend to expand of BPO sector rapidly and make remittance for the country. Bangladesh supplies 16% of the total online workers, the second highest after India which provides 24%, according to 2017 Online Labor Index of Oxford Internet Institute.

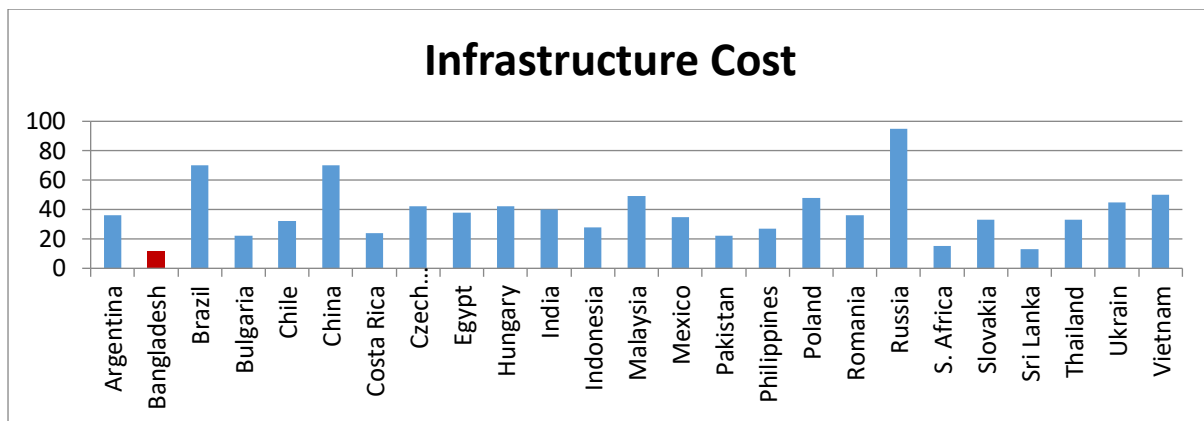
Population & Demographic: 50% of Population is below 28 years of age. Bangladeshis are known for hard work and commitment even attrition rate is very low as compared to employees of other countries.

Cheaper Manpower: the significant pool of young work force is available at a much lower wage as compared to other outsourcing countries. The wage rate in Bangladesh in IT industry is over 50% cheaper than other countries.

Cheaper Infrastructure Cost- Costs of infrastructure in Bangladesh are fairly low compared to destinations in Asia particularly in terms of office spaces. The rental of office space in Dhaka



is 20% lower of that in Delhi and 40% of Manila.



Availability of Experienced Professionals

Recruiting new employees and training them involves a lot of hassle and is a huge cost to the company. When the tasks are outsourced to an already established company with all the resources, the troubles of hiring and training is conveniently avoided.

Internet Bandwidth: The internet bandwidth cost in Bangladesh is comparatively very cheap than other countries. It is 50% cheaper as compared to India.

Govt. Support: Govt. of Bangladesh is taking significant steps in making Bangladesh a favorable destination of business for foreign investors. Policy like exemption of direct taxes in IT sector is helping in growth of the country.

Access to the Latest Updated Technologies

Buying a licensed version of the latest software and other technologies is very expensive. This proposition is also risky, especially for small to medium-sized businesses who cannot afford to dedicate a steady budget for buying the latest technologies. Therefore, it becomes difficult for a company to stay updated with the latest developments. Outsourcing to companies that already have access to the technology and have the relevant expertise therefore proves to be more efficient.

Income through Staying at Home:

It's a big opportunity to make income by staying at home. Most of the students are becoming unemployed, they cannot get their expected job after huge struggle, moreover, they can't expect job, beside these, and they can take outsourcing as a personal income source. On the other

hand, it's a big opportunity to make income by staying at home, so outsourcing has become so popular among people specially for women.

3.4.8 Prospects of Outsourcing in Bangladesh:

Bangladesh is a small country with the large population. There are not enough job fields as required. So many people are unemployed after completing education. Freelancing or outsourcing is the vast marketplace which is online based.

The development in IT sector in Bangladesh has been in the last ten years. The number of internet users in Bangladesh exceeded 100 million for the first time to reach 103.253 million users, according to newly released data from the country's regulator, the Bangladesh Telecommunication Regulatory Commission (BTRC).

For the first time, Bangladesh IT services have been included in AT Kearney's report GSLI (Global Services Location Index). It will attract Foreign Investors to invest in IT sector of Bangladesh. This will also enhance outsourcing industry and develop more freelancers in Bangladesh. Bangladesh is presently securing the 26th position for IT outsourcing. BASIS will work to bring Bangladesh within the top 10 countries.

At present, Bangladesh has become the major destination for outsourcing business. Recently, the European Commission has selected Bangladesh as an ideal destination for outsourcing in the world. BASIS (Bangladesh Associations for Software and Information Services), BCC (Bangladesh Computer Council), the apex body of Bangladesh IT software and service providers (IT & BPO), BCS (Bangladesh Computer Samity) are working to build up and expand the sector of outsourcing. In the international outsourcing marketplace, the share of Bangladesh goes up day by day. Selection of Bangladesh among best spot for IT jobs outsourcing is a prestigious issue. In spite of many obstacles in outsourcing, the opportunities are immense.

Bangladesh Can Be an Alternative BPO Hub

Bangladesh can be an alternative destination for business process outsourcing (BPO) with its young and dedicated IT talents, said ASM Mohiuddin Monem, chairman of ServEngine Ltd. The Dhaka-based BPO Company has already proved that it is possible to compete with other regional countries such as India and the Philippines that are the pioneer in the industry.

It has ranked 51 countries worldwide as the best destinations for outsourcing of software and IT-enabled services. It has published a report which stated that it had marked Bangladesh among best spots for IT jobs outsourcing. Bangladesh has secured top spot among 51 countries, including India, China, Australia, Canada and the UK regarding ‘Financial Attractiveness’. In the index, Bangladesh has got the 26th position. Among the listed countries, India has obtained the 1st position, Pakistan in the 25th position, the United Kingdom (UK) gained 27th, Canada 37th; Australia ranked 49th and Ireland got the lowest position.

1. Bangladesh became 3rd in the list of top ten on oDesk.
2. The study of AT Kearney Global says that Bangladesh has become a central point for outsourcing jobs via online marketplaces such as oDesk. Bangladesh has shown tremendous improvement on oDesk. In 2009, the country accounted for only 2% of the total hours worked on oDesk. At present, it accounts for 10%. Bangladesh has become the 3rd (third) country for contractors on oDesk. It is now behind two countries, the Philippines, and India. It has moved quickly to the forefront of entrepreneurial activity.

Bangladesh Received another 1,500Gbps Bandwidth from its Second Submarine Cable Network

The connection of Bangladesh to its second submarine communications cable presented the country with an unusual but not unwanted problem: what to do with the excess capacity.

Over 550,000 miles of fiber optic cables are buried under the world's oceans to deliver the bulk of emails, web pages, and other electronic communications from one continent to another at the speed of light.

Bangladesh's first submarine cables network SEA-ME-WE 4 has been providing the country with 250Gbps of bandwidth for nearly a decade. Until now, the remainder of the country's 400Gbps demand has been met by six international extraterrestrial cable associations.

However, the connection to the SEA-ME-WE 5 undersea network provided the country with another 200Gbps bandwidth, which will eventually rise to 1,500Gbps.

Present Condition and Attempts for Inspiring Outsourcing

Rapid digitalization and a high rate of educated unemployment has made Bangladesh the second largest exporter of online labor.

According to the Oxford Internet Institute (OII), about 500,000 active freelancers are working regularly, out of 650,000 registered freelancers in the country; between them they are generating \$100 million annually, according to the ICT Division of Bangladesh. There are about 151 outsourcing companies. In the last few years BPO (Businesses process outsourcing) sector has gone through massive expansion and it has achieved 24 percent year growth year after year and it shows signs of more expansion. India is the largest supplier of online labor with close to 24% of total global freelance workers, followed by Bangladesh (16%) and the US (12%). Different countries focus on different sectors of freelancing services. For instance, technology and software development is dominated by Indian freelancers, while Bangladesh is the top supplier of sales and marketing support services. IT skills and English are the main competences of Bangladesh for being a new hub for BPO operators. Labor cost is around \$8 per hour than other BPO countries like Philippines (\$20) and India (\$15). 180-million-dollar worth of market share is currently owned by Bangladesh and if Bangladesh can utilize this great opportunity this sector can become the second biggest to earn foreign currency. It is a very well-known fact that there is a lack of job opportunity in Bangladesh but due to the BPO sector alone it is now providing jobs to 45,000 people, which at the start had only 900

people working in the whole sector, this shows the promise this sector holds. In recent years, through online outsourcing, a large number of entrepreneurs and individuals with their hard work and talent are contributing to society and the country. Accumulating all of the cash that Bangladeshi freelancers are earning about one crore Bangladeshi Taka per day from various freelancing marketplaces. For the past few years, Bangladesh Association of Software and Information Services has been arranging an award program every year to inspire more people in doing online outsourcing jobs in Bangladesh.

Enhancement of Women Freelancing Career in Bangladesh

The most common reasons behind female unemployment in Bangladesh are the unfavorable working environment, different types of social issues, including family support, road safety, etc. For these matters, sometimes women don't get support from their family for working outside. Gender discrimination is a burning issue in Bangladesh. Women usually get less money for the same amount of work than their male coworkers.

Above issues can be solved by enhancing women freelancing in Bangladesh. An outsourcing or freelancing career can be a great opportunity for women in Bangladesh. In this way, they can get the chance to manage their family and continue their career.

3.5 Challenges of Outsourcing in Bangladesh

There are few obstacles we need to cross before declaring ourselves one of the Giant. Bangladesh has the potential to be considered as one of the biggest players in the outsourcing industry. Gartner gave Bangladesh a "poor" rating in three vital areas – infrastructure, language skills and data, and intellectual property security. Poor infrastructure, including frequent power crises and slow and unreliable Internet connections are the most immediate problems for outsourcing.

Power Crisis

Bangladesh's businesses have suffered by power supply for a very long time. It is not only an obstacle for outsourcing businesses, but also other types of manufacturing and non-manufacturing business.

Low Internet Speed

Internet might be an old thing for rest of the world, but it's relatively new in our country. Still now we are very much behind than rest of the world. Our country has two submarine Internet cables but still we do not have uninterruptable internet connection.

Money Transaction Problem

Payment type is a big barrier in our outsourcing industry. Everywhere in this world, people work to make their living. Outsourcing or freelancing is not different from them as well. But we get stuck to our old traditional way of payment type. Either it's check or cash. Now a day, lots of companies pay their employees by the salary account from different banks. But nothing is more important for an employee than a secure payment method. Now a day, freelancers get paid by their different accounts in bank, which is safe. But there is other payment method like "Paypal". But currently Bangladesh Government is not allowing any online transaction. Without any confusion what-so-ever, Bangladeshi web-based businesses have indicated it as the biggest problem they face. Almost all the respondents are affected by this trouble while dealing internationally. The biggest problem to run the freelancing business, again most of the firms have specified international monetary transaction method as the most upsetting one.

Infrastructure Crisis:

Infrastructural support is crucial when any industry needs growth. Government and private organizations should provide input simultaneously to create a constant growth rate for an industry. IT outsourcing in Bangladesh is still in its early age. To make it mature, infrastructural improvement is so important which have been discussed through survey with six crucial topics for IT outsourcing industry.

Political Instability:

Politics and business run on the same way. Sometimes government want to control businesses, sometimes businesses can acquire power to corrupt government. So, it has a big deal with the industry. This is a big concern in Bangladesh. There are lots of reasons behind loosing international market by political violence.

Marketing Empowerment and English efficiency:








Though we are in leading position in outsourcing market, but we are not reaching at the highest level just because of having lack in marketing knowledge. So, our people should also acquire the power of marketing and this technical knowledge will help them in their practical field while communicating. Though we have a good number of human resources, many of them cannot communicate in English fluently.

Intellectual Property Rights:

Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) maintenance and providing security for those properties should be maintained through government rules strictly, because fraud and piracy rate is at a very risky stage for any industry. Due to numerous incidents of software piracy made it still remaining the bad images of Bangladesh. Govt. should take care of this soon under IT acts and rules.

3.6 Recommendations

Government should start taking initiatives to increase their speed of infrastructural development. The top priority which is given by the employers is the quality of work. Individuals or companies should concentrate on top notch quality of service to fulfill employer needs. If the provided service is superior in quality, it will not only bring goodwill for the company, but also raises the nations' honor. So, government should establish more training institutes to train our people and also, they should impose authority to private sectors so that, they can also train to deliver greater quality of work. There are some key recommendations as follows:

-  Boost up infrastructural development.
-  A stable resolution for electricity/power crisis.
-  Proper delivery of bandwidth throughout the whole country.
-  Issue new sets of rules and regulation for the outsourcing to grow more.
-  Encourage youth and unemployed people on outsourcing.
-  Set up more training centers.
-  Strict implementation of copy right law under ICT act.
