

## Home Bangladesh Govt makes 'huge reformation' in edu sector: Nahid

Education minister Nurul Islam Nahid on Wednesday claimed that incumbent government, under the leadership of prime minister Sheikh Hasina, has brought huge 'reformation' in the education sector of the country.

The minister made the remarks while attending the 12th convocation programme of BRAC University as a representative of the president Abdul Hamid in Khagan area of Biralia union in Savar, on the outskirts of Dhaka.

"People have to come forward with a view to contribute for welfare and sacrifice rather than making profit or business in education sector," said Nahid.

Incumbent government has permitted to set up several new public and private universities to meet the demand of higher education in the country and has taken necessary steps to sustain its quality, he added.

University Grants Commission (UGC) chairman professor Abdul Mannan, chairperson of BRAC University board of trustee Sir Fazle Hasan Abed, university's vice chancellor Syed Saad Andaleeb were also present here.

President Md Abdul Hamid is currently in Istanbul of Tukey to attend the Extra-ordinary Summit of Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC).

Turkish president Recep Tayyip Erdogan convened the summit of the world's main pan-Islamic body, seeking a coordinated response to the recognition by US president Donald Trump of Jerusalem as Israel's capital.
