Google offers research on Bangla

Online search engine Google expressed its interest in further research on Bangla language processing and development of more resources for Bangla.

Google representative, Divon Lan, acquainted this during his visit to BRAC University in the capital on February 16, said a press release.

It was the first official visit of any Google representative in Bangladesh, it added.

He met with some faculty members of the university's computer science and engineering department and took part in a question-answer session with the students.

Divon Lan said Google was interested in research on Bengali language processing and developing more resources for Bangla such as parallel corpora and other relevant data in collaboration with BRAC University.

In the question-answer session, Divon informed the students about Google's expectation for potential employees.

The CSE department chairperson, Mumit Khan, was also present at the programme.
