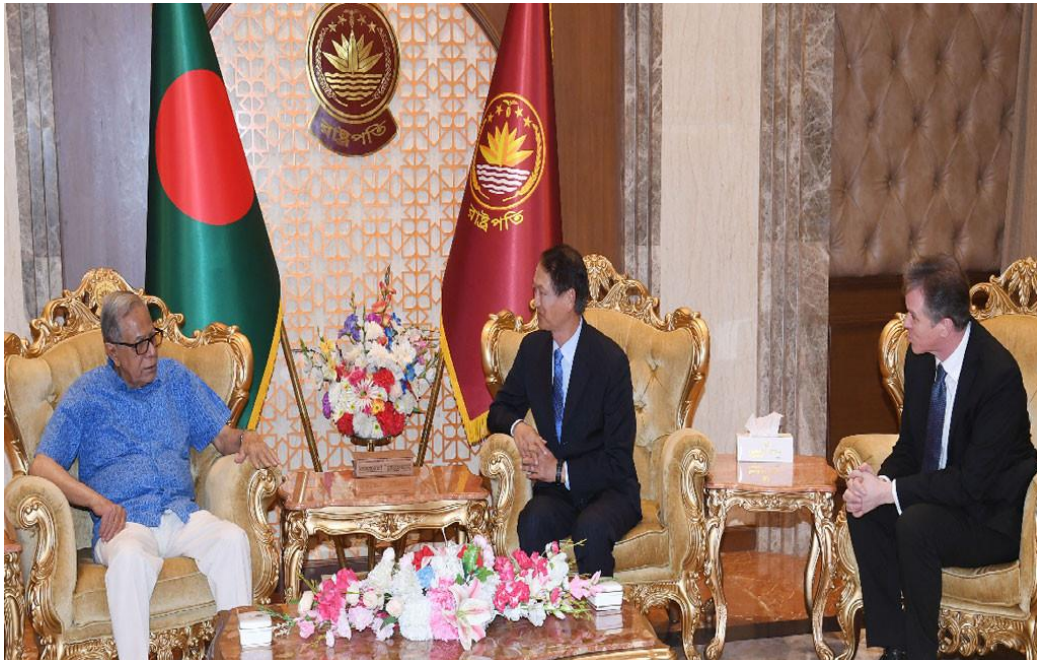


President Hamid wants universities to ensure quality education
